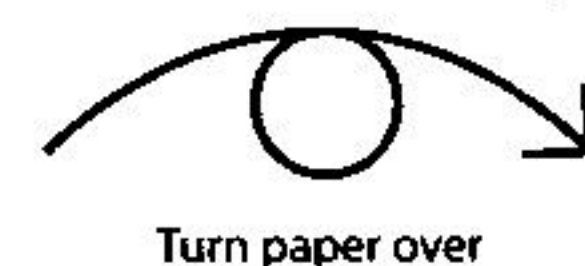
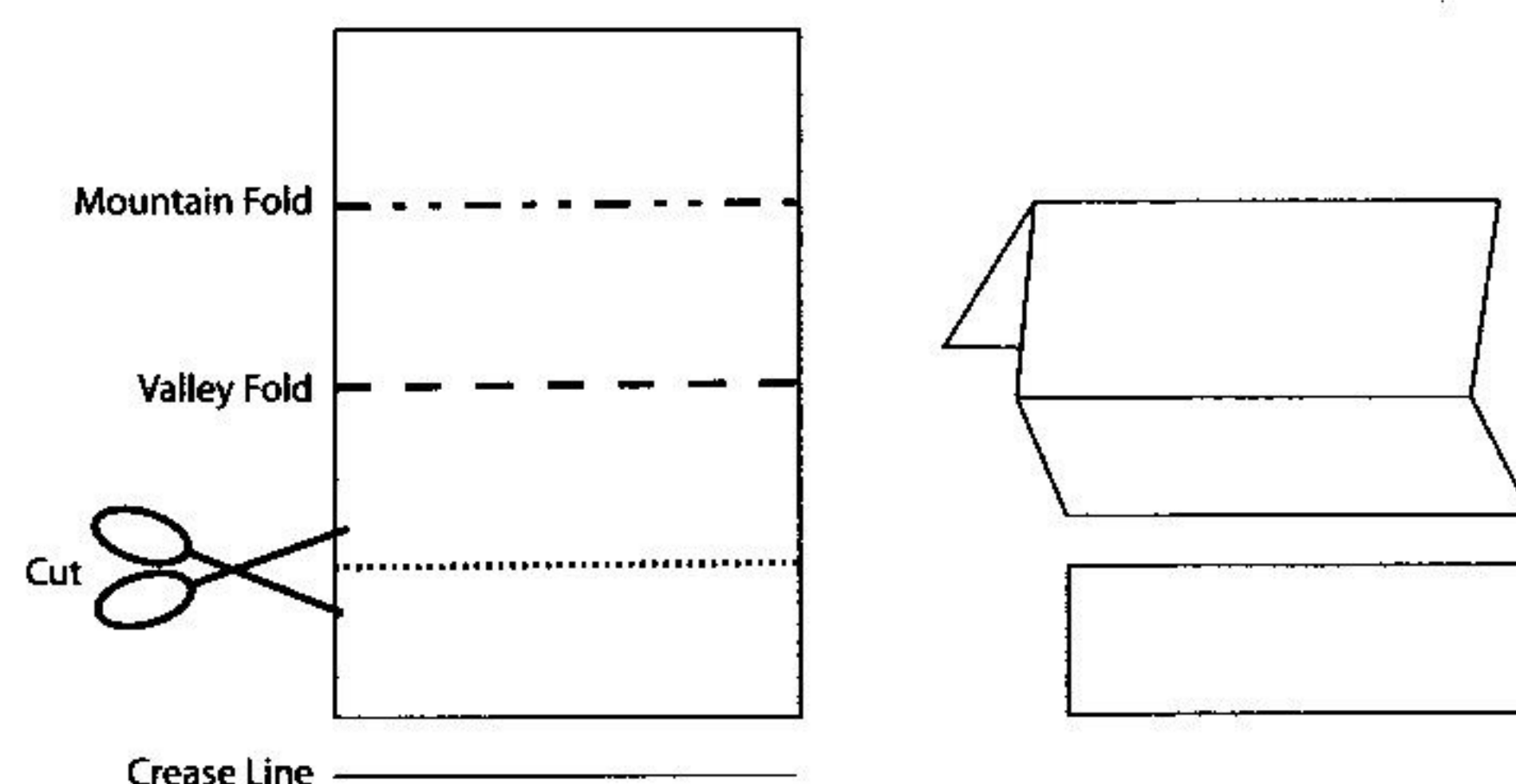


WELCOME to the fascinating world of origami!
Here are some tips to keep in mind while folding:

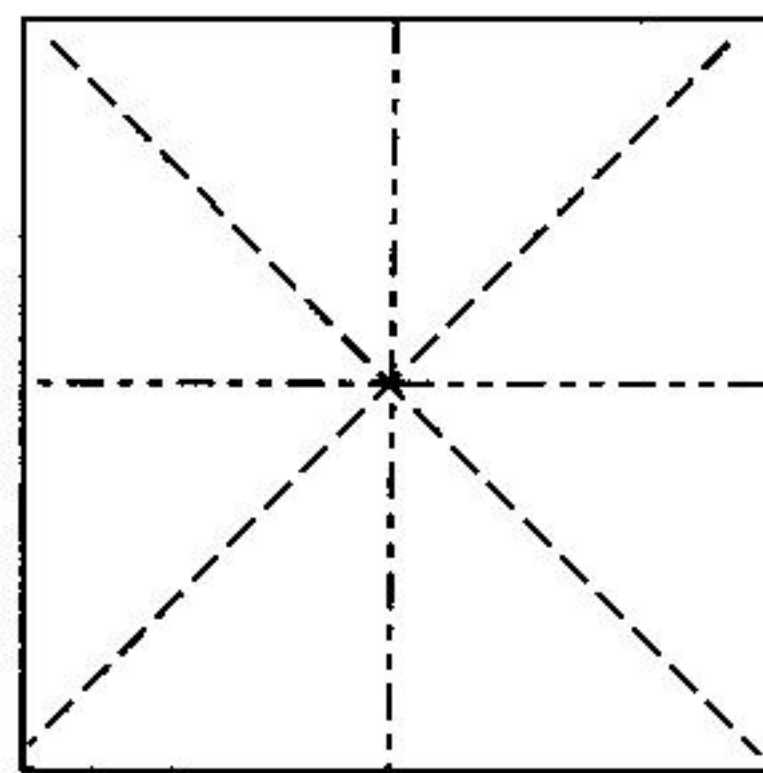
- ▶ Pay careful attention to the dotted lines and arrows showing you which way to fold the paper.
- ▶ Always make sharp creases, using your fingernail, the bowl of a spoon, or a ruler to help smooth the folds.
- ▶ Keep a supply of scrap paper handy to practice making an object. Feel free to label your paper to match the diagrams.
- ▶ When following each step, it helps to look at the next diagram to see what the result should look like.
- ▶ When making a fold with tapered points, start at the narrowest portion of the point and then crease upward or outward from there.

Have fun folding!

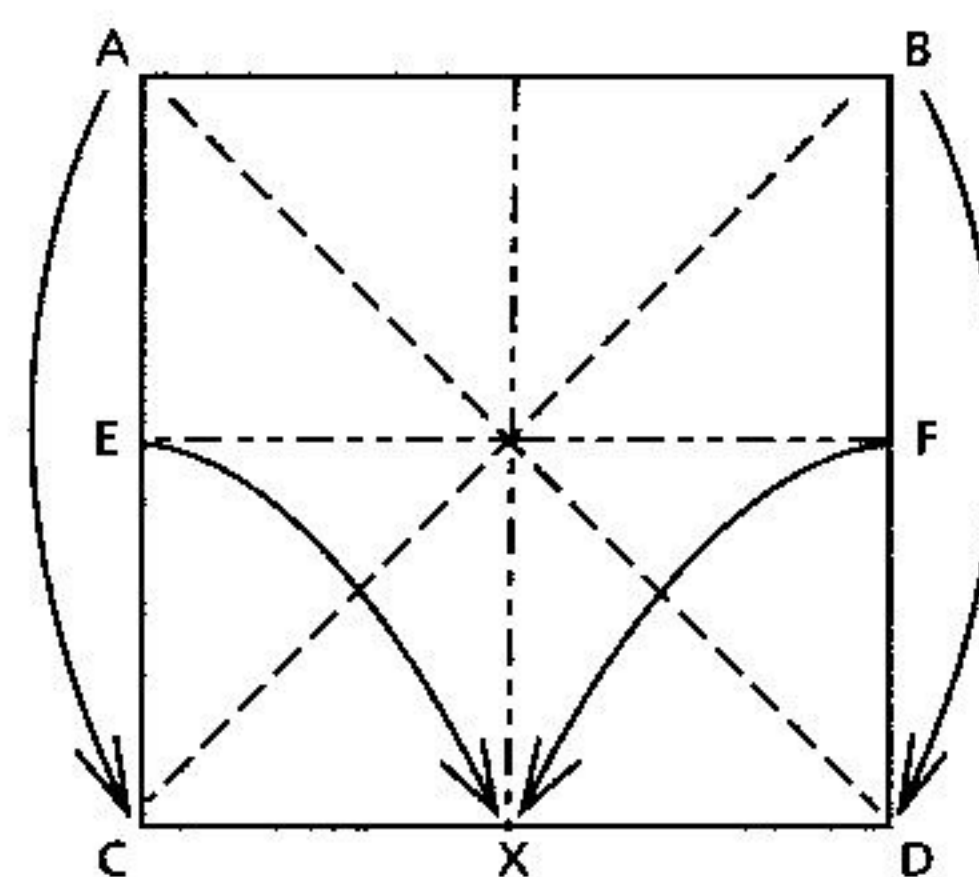
Origami Symbols Key



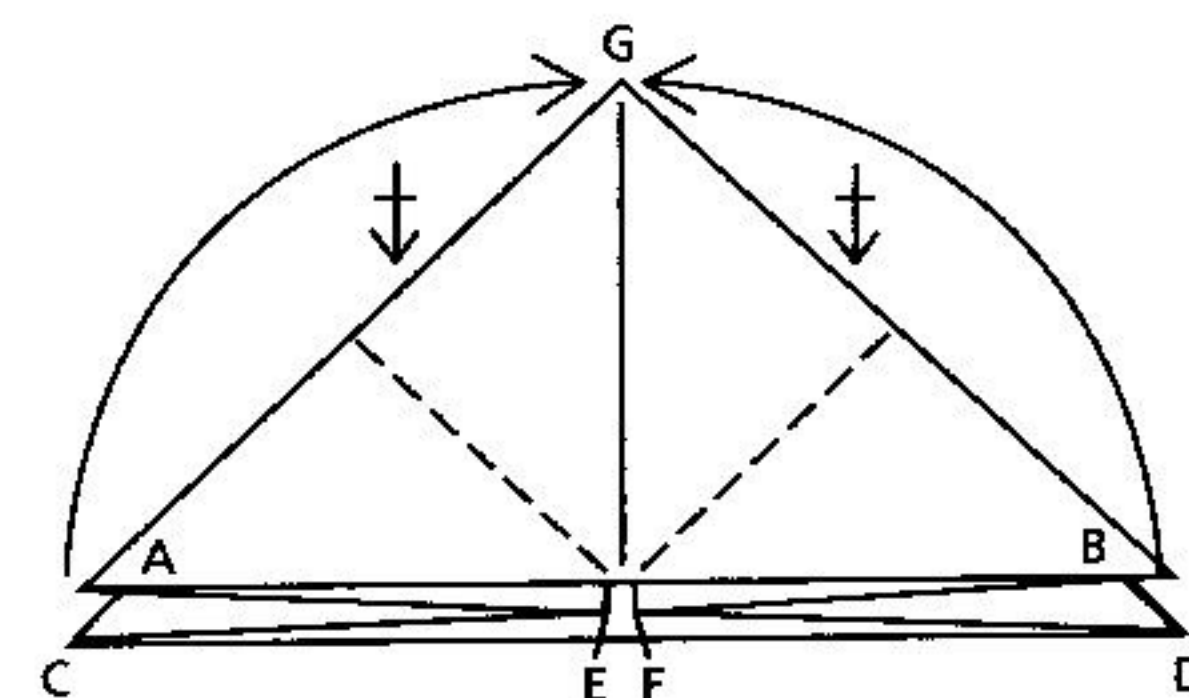
Balloon



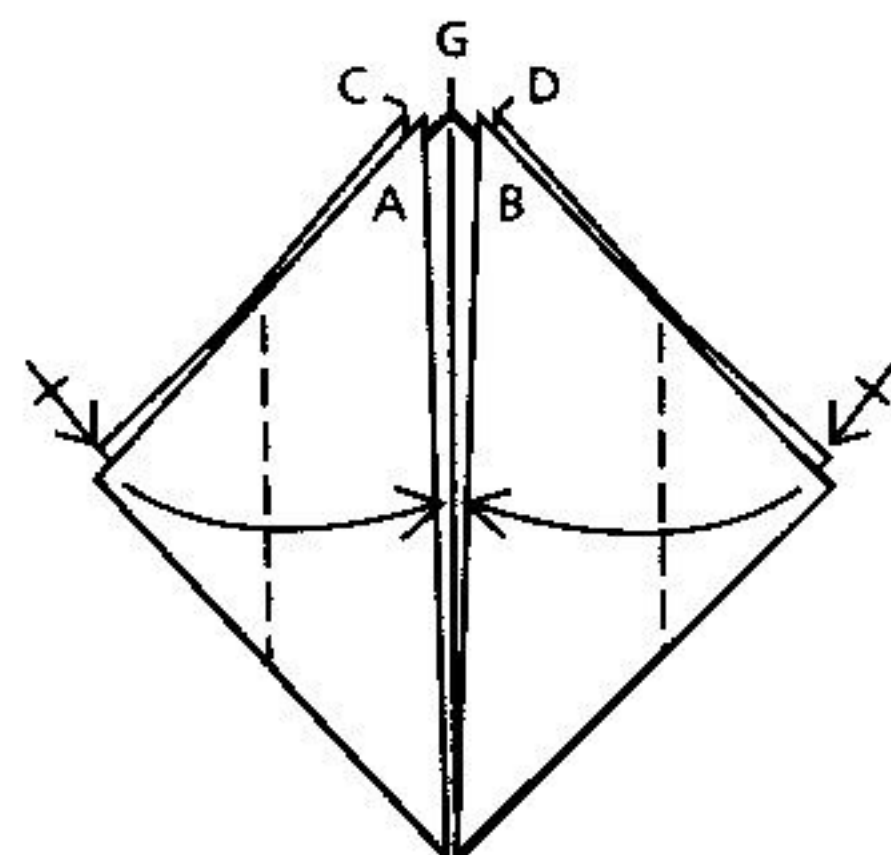
1. Make mountain folds edge to edge, and valley folds corner to corner.



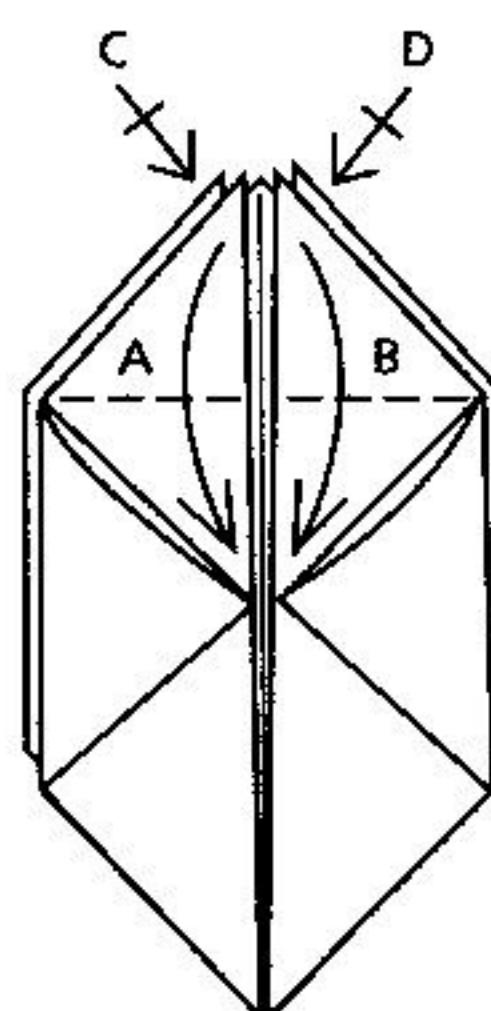
2. Mountain-fold the E and F edges, bringing A down to C and B down to D.



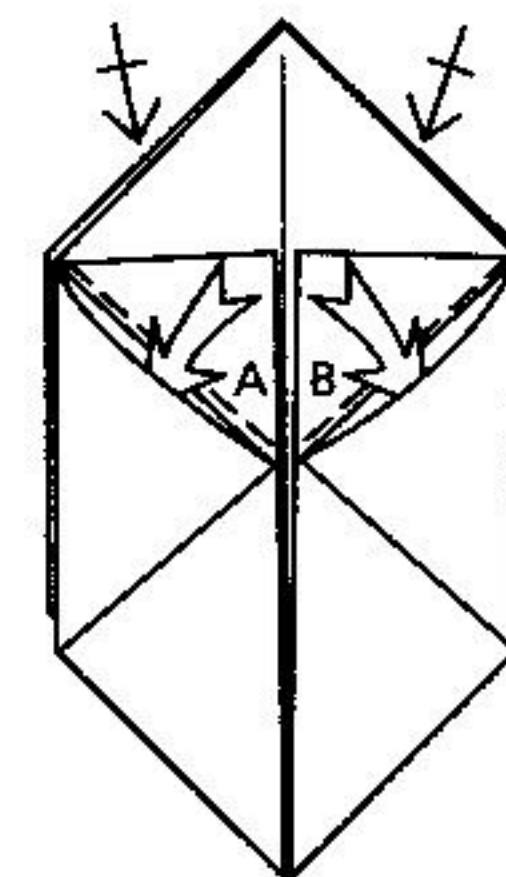
3. Fold A and B up to G. Repeat behind with C and D.



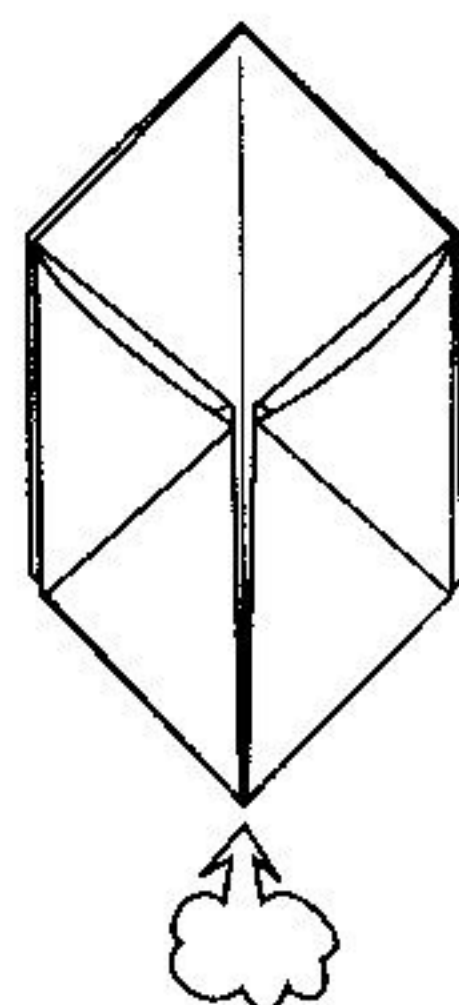
4. Fold in the left and right front corners to meet at the center of the paper. Repeat behind.



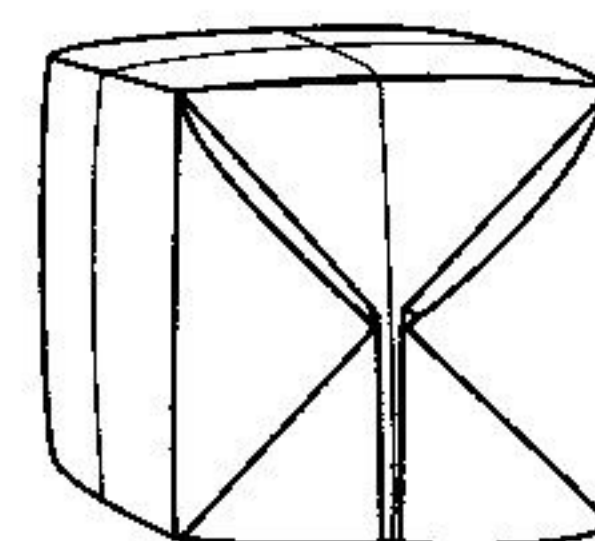
5. Fold down A and B. Repeat behind with C and D.



6. Tuck the flaps into the pockets. Repeat behind.

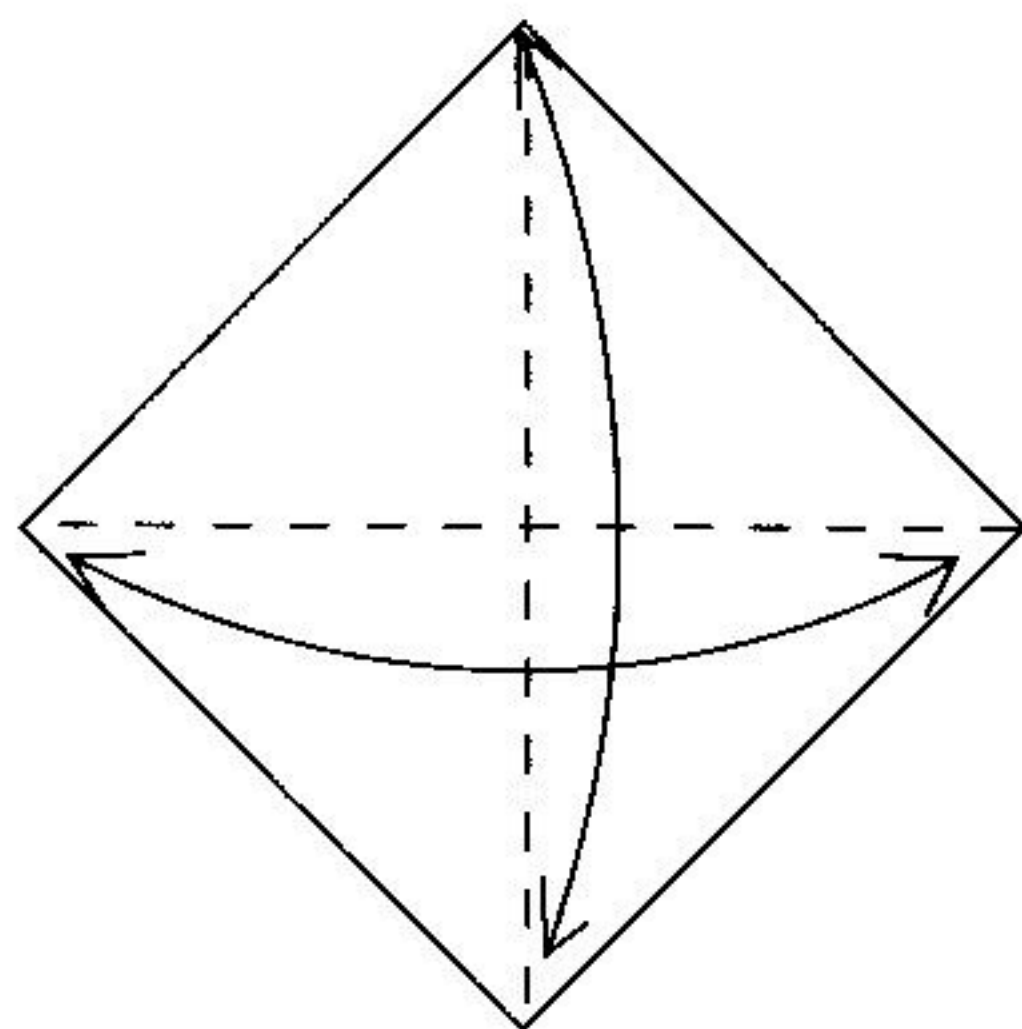


7. Blow air into opening.

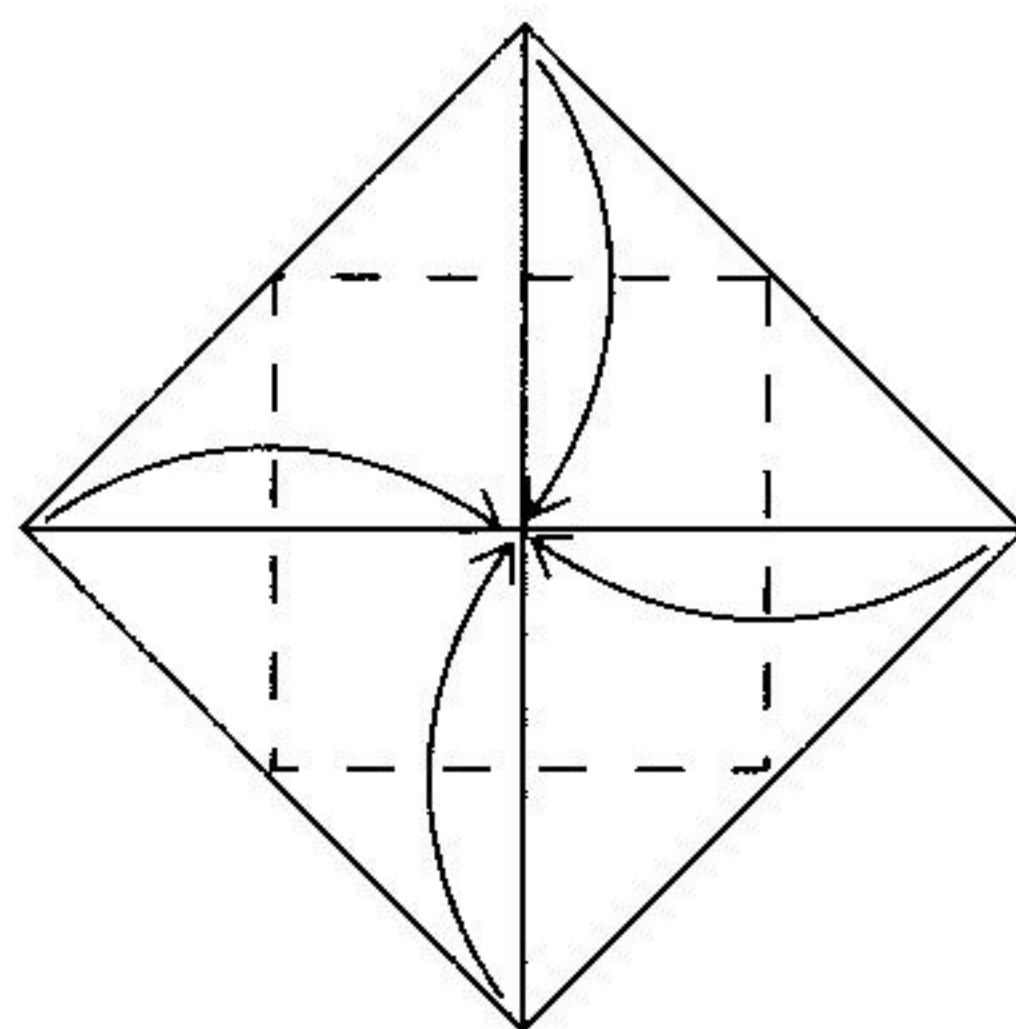


8. The finished Balloon.

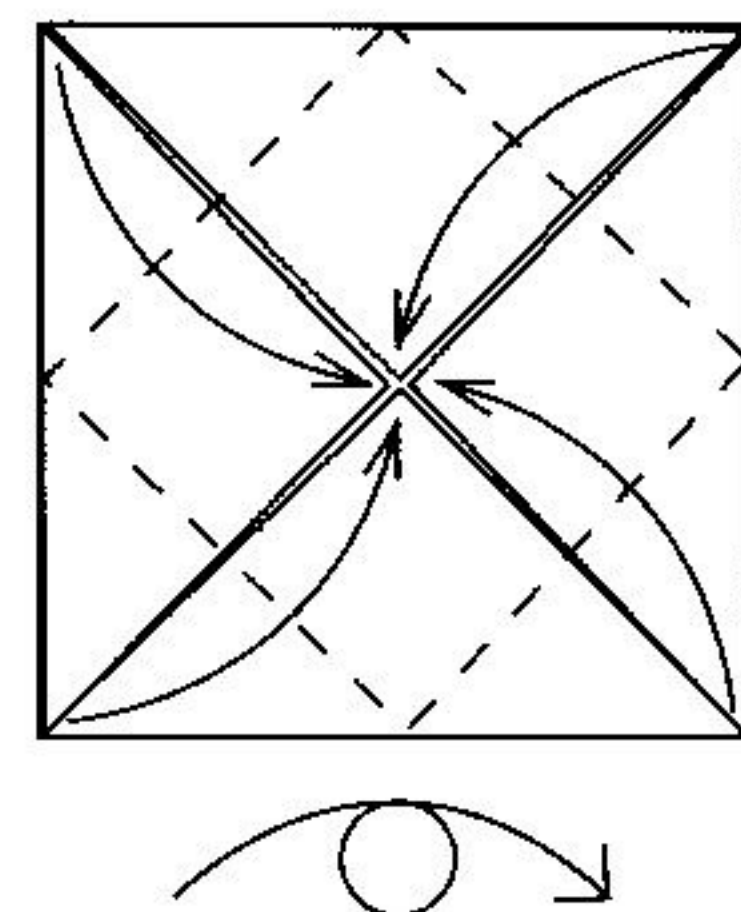
Lotus



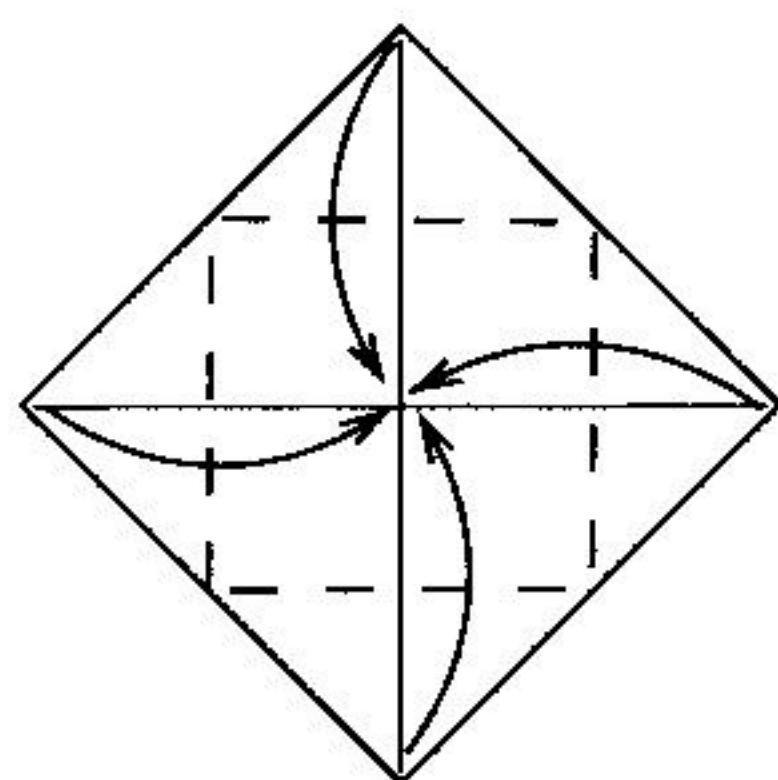
1. Fold in half, corner to corner, both ways to make crossing creases. Unfold.



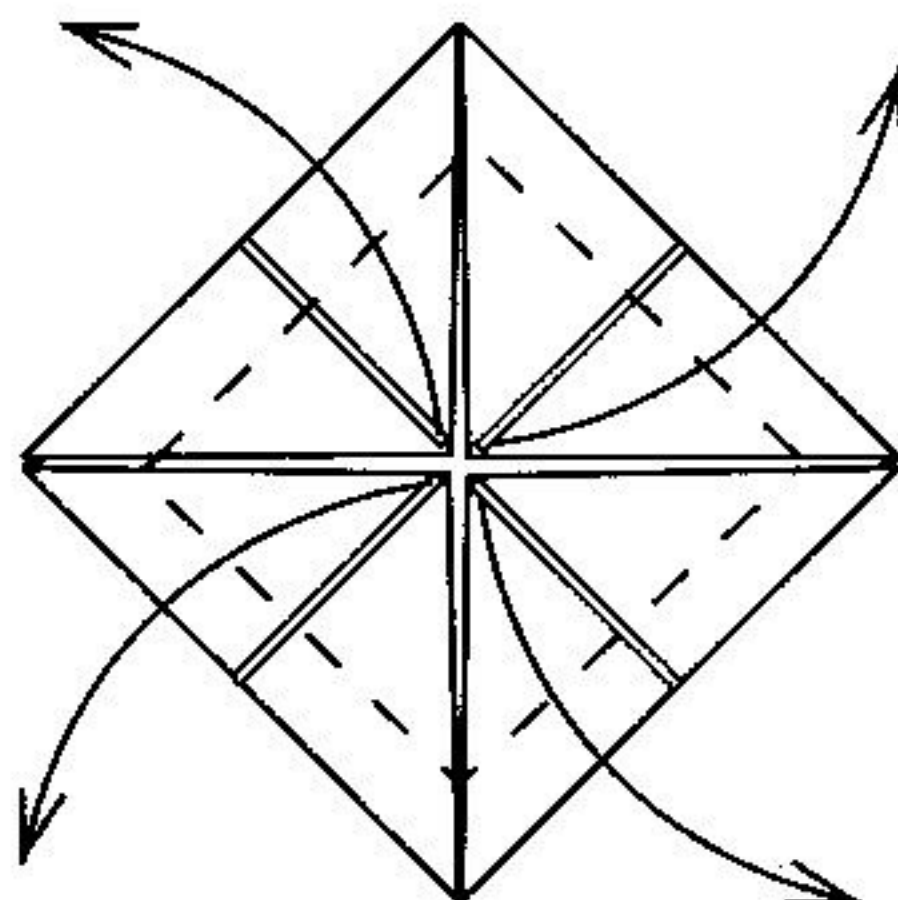
2. Fold all corners to meet at the center.



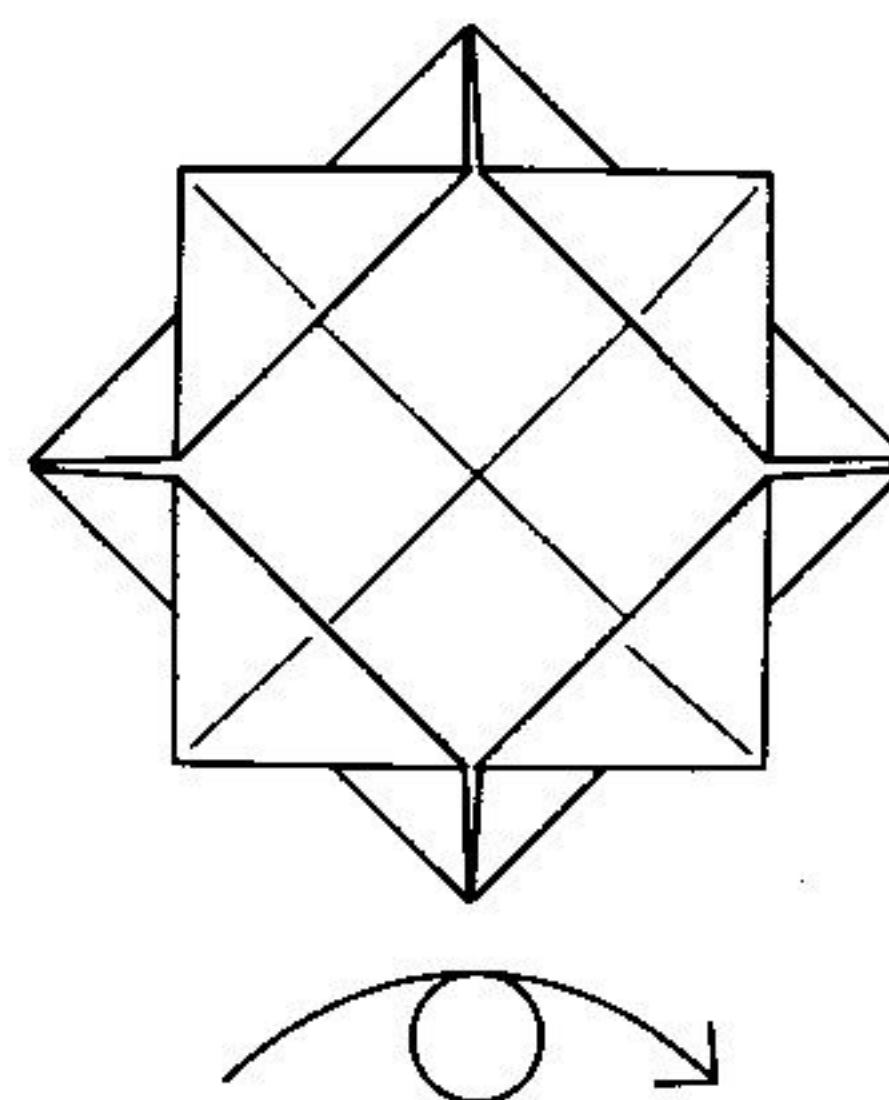
3. Fold corners to the center. Turn over.



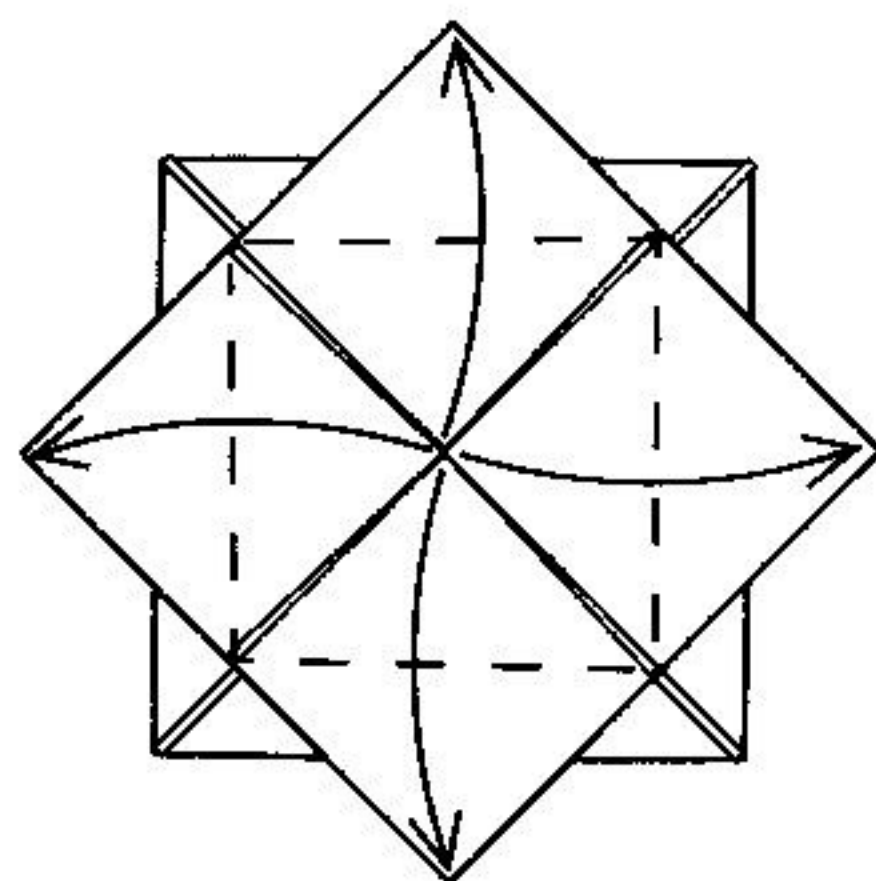
4. Fold corners to the center.



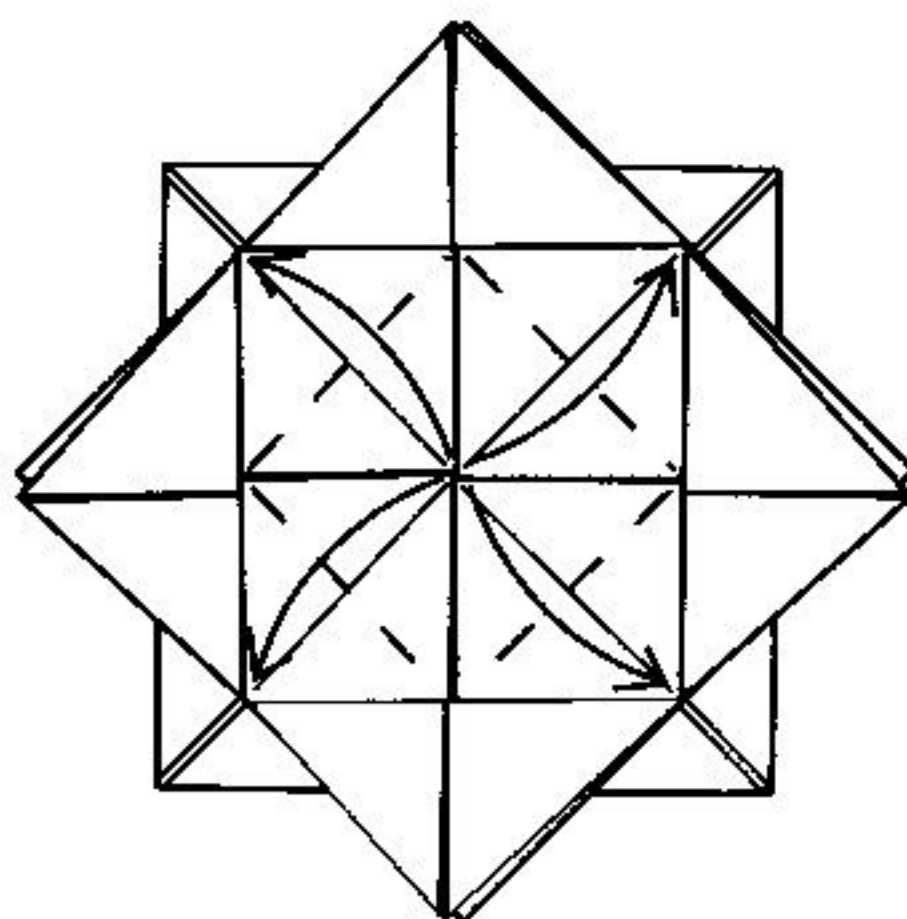
5. Fold out each corner beyond the edges of the square.



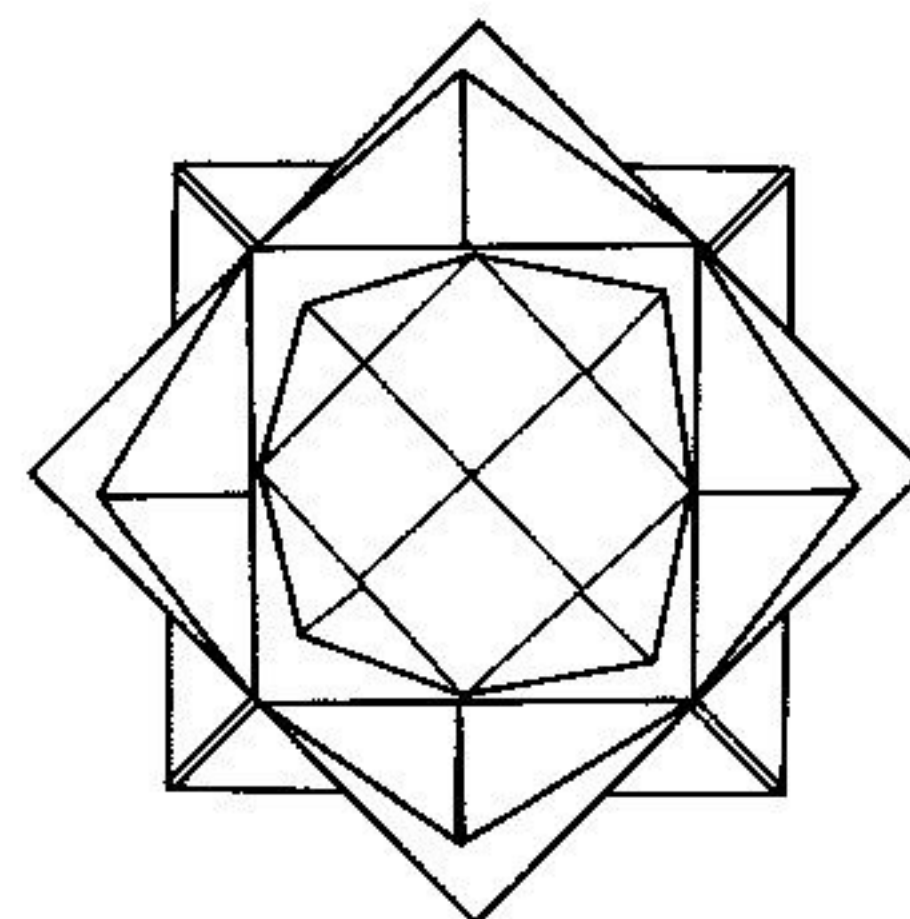
6. Turn over.



7. Fold out corners.

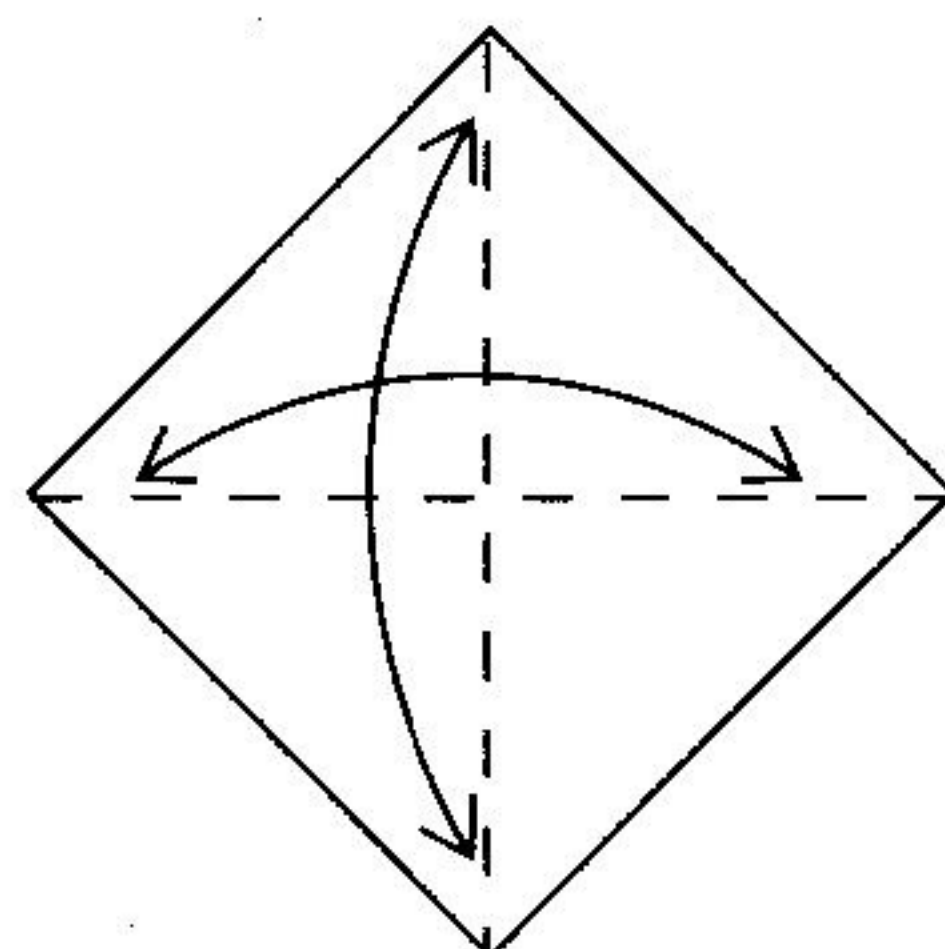


8. Fold out corners.

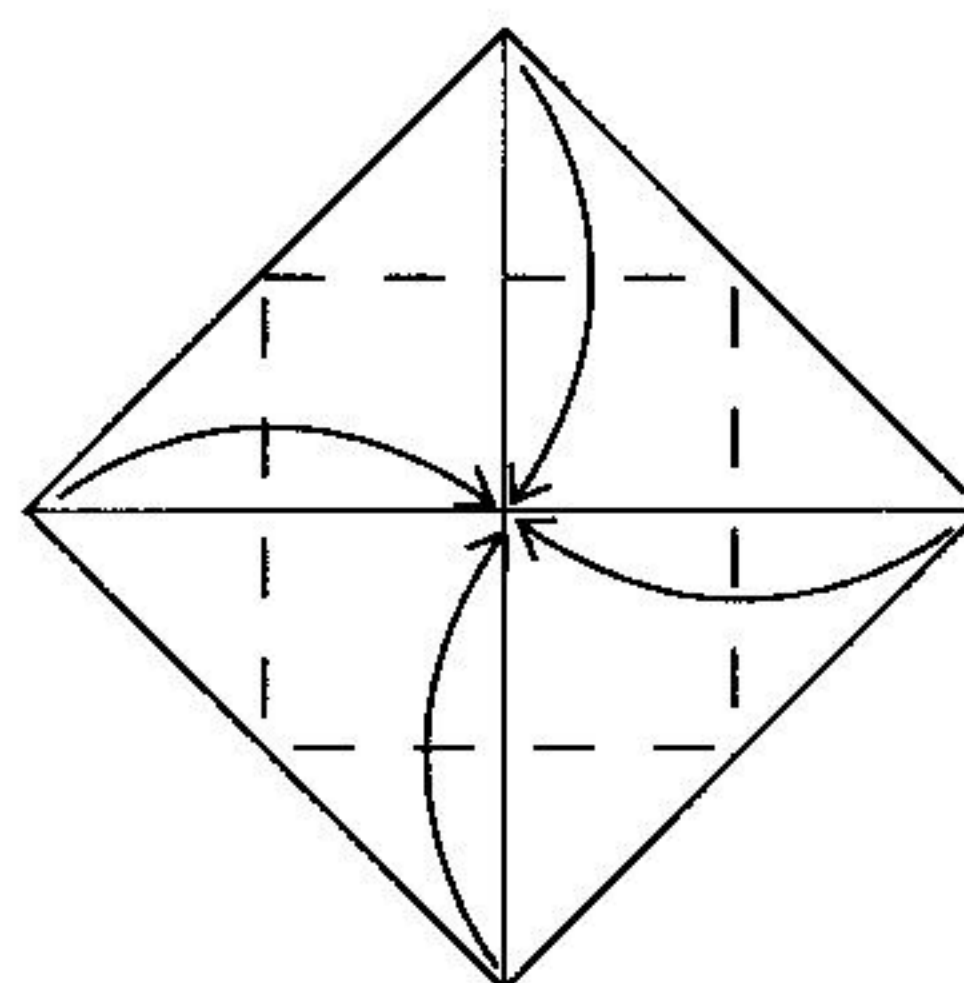


9. The finished Lotus.

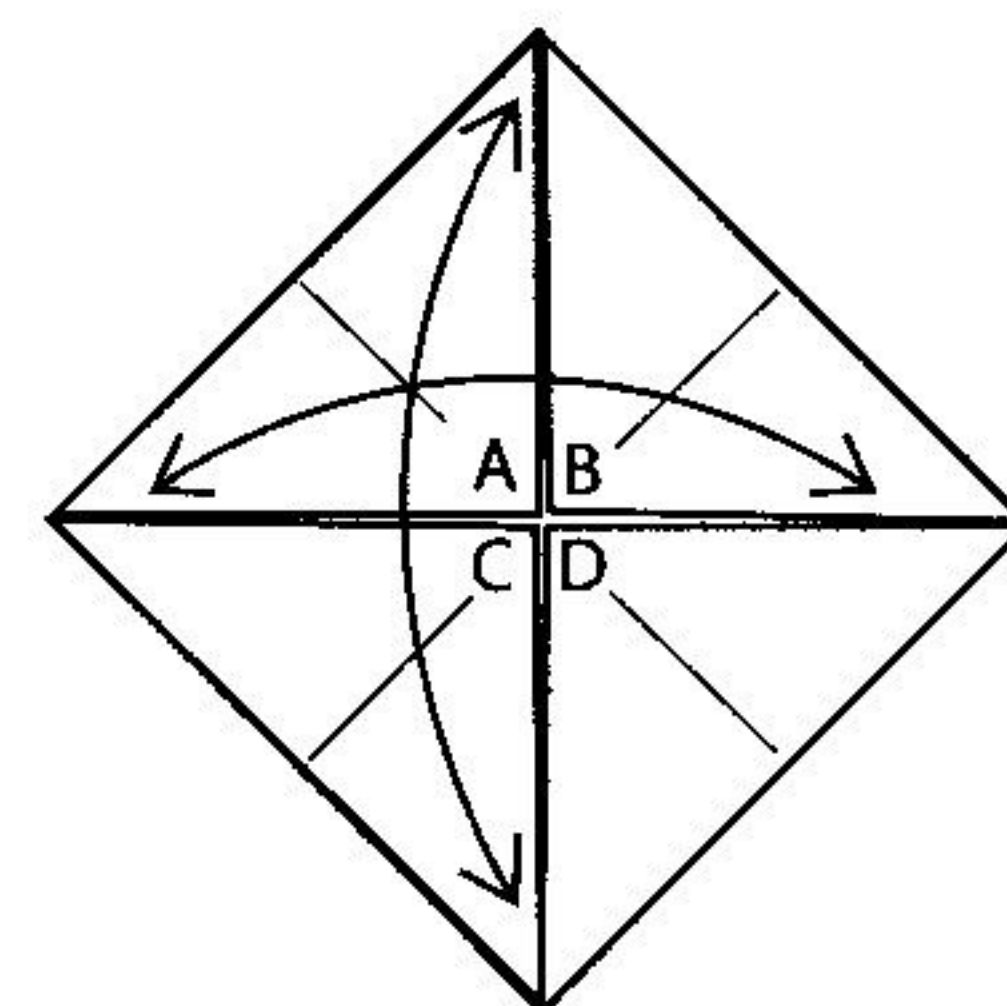
Chameleon



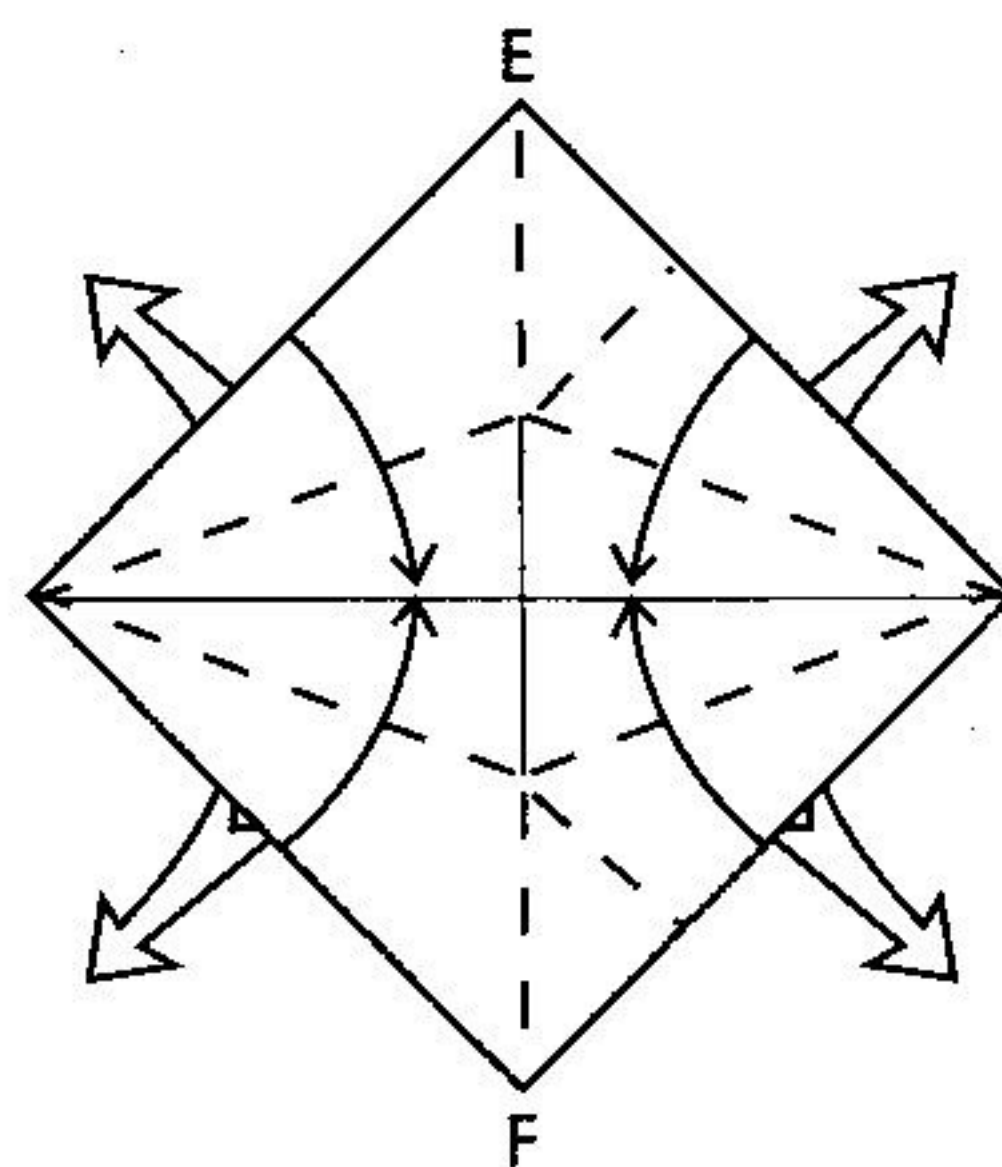
1. Begin color side up. Valley-fold in half corner to corner, both ways, and unfold.



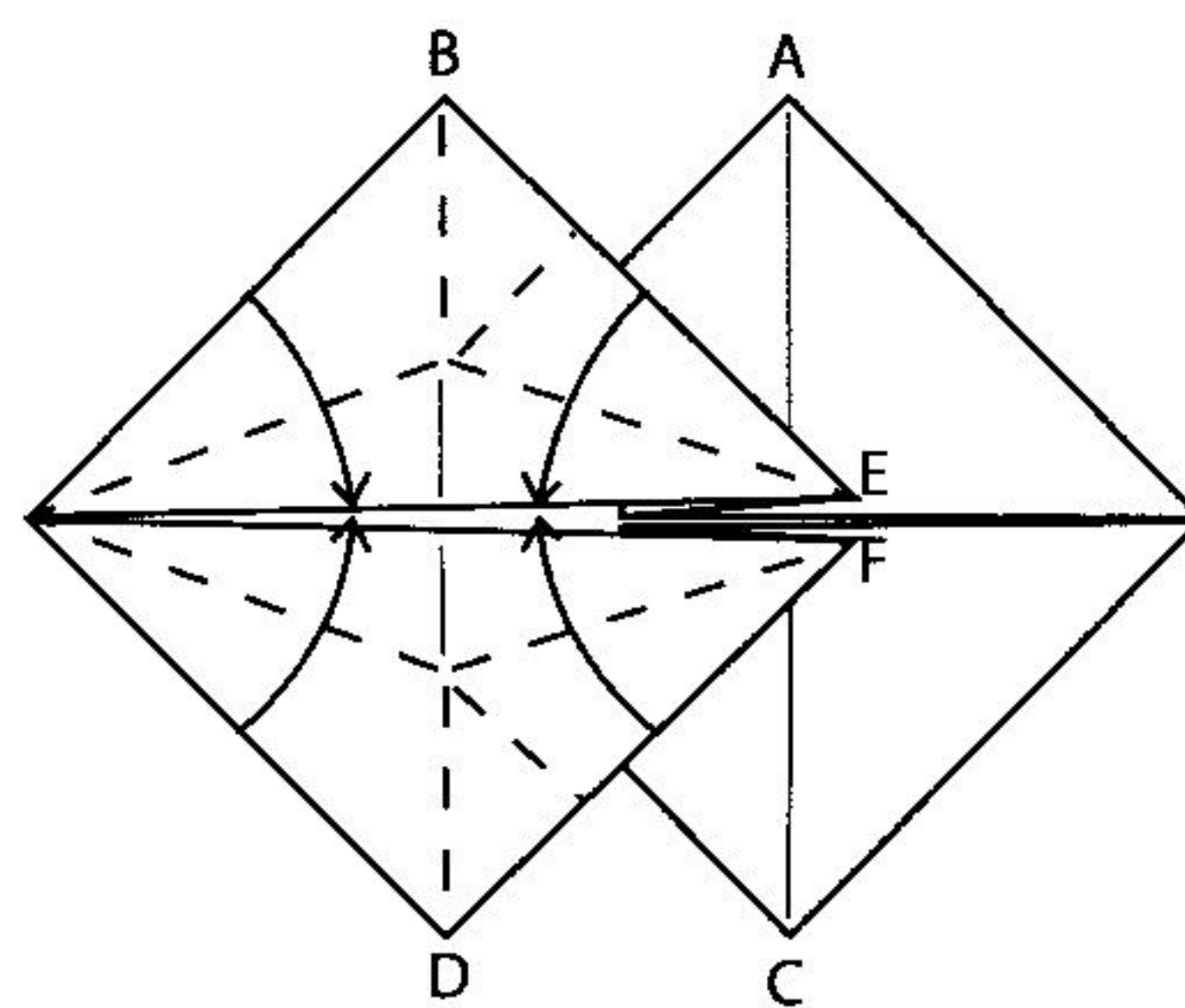
2. Fold all four corners to the center.



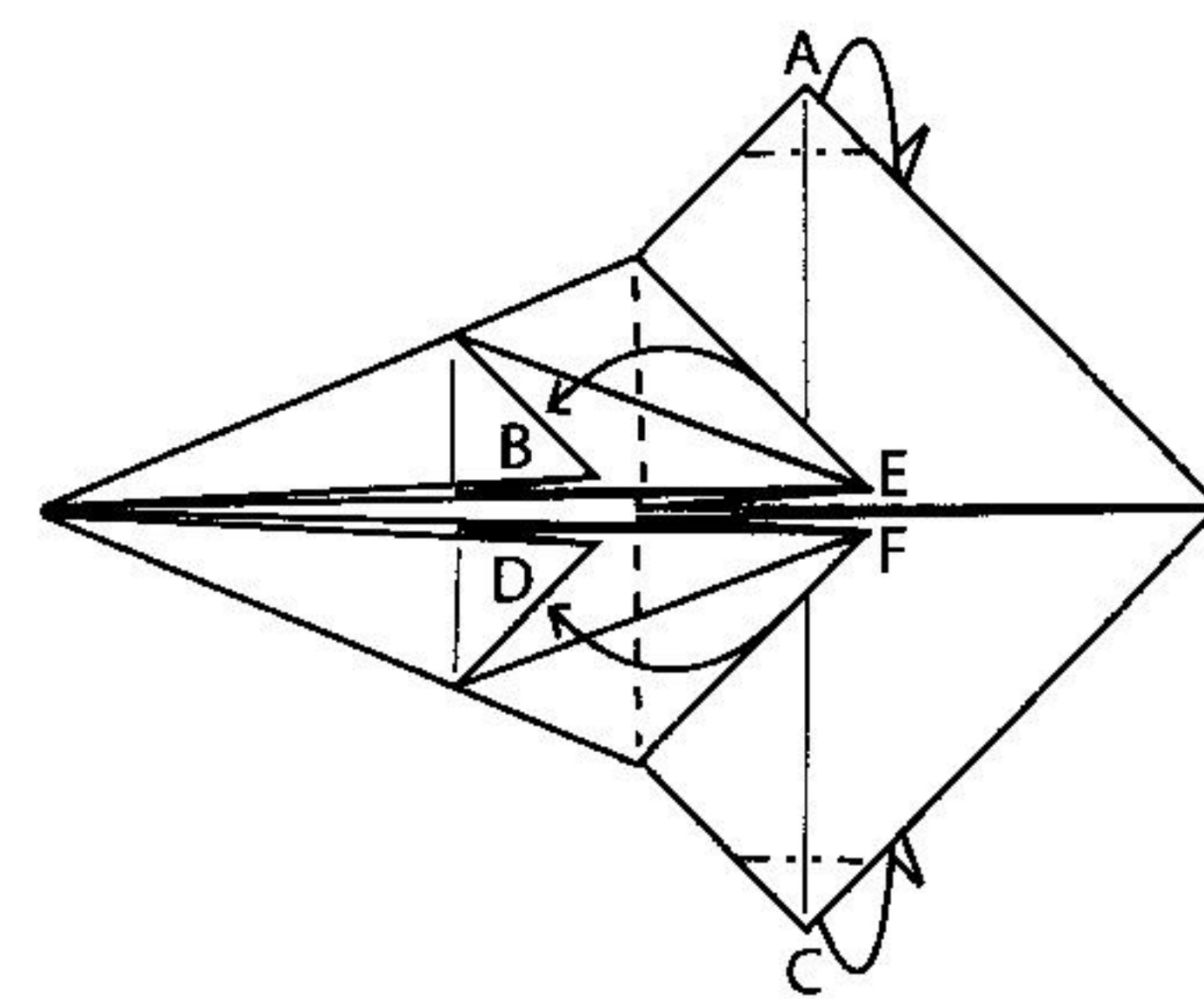
3. Fold in half corner to corner both ways and unfold. Turn over.



4. Fold in all four sides of the square to the center while folding corners E and F in half and then to the right. Allow the corners from underneath to come out.

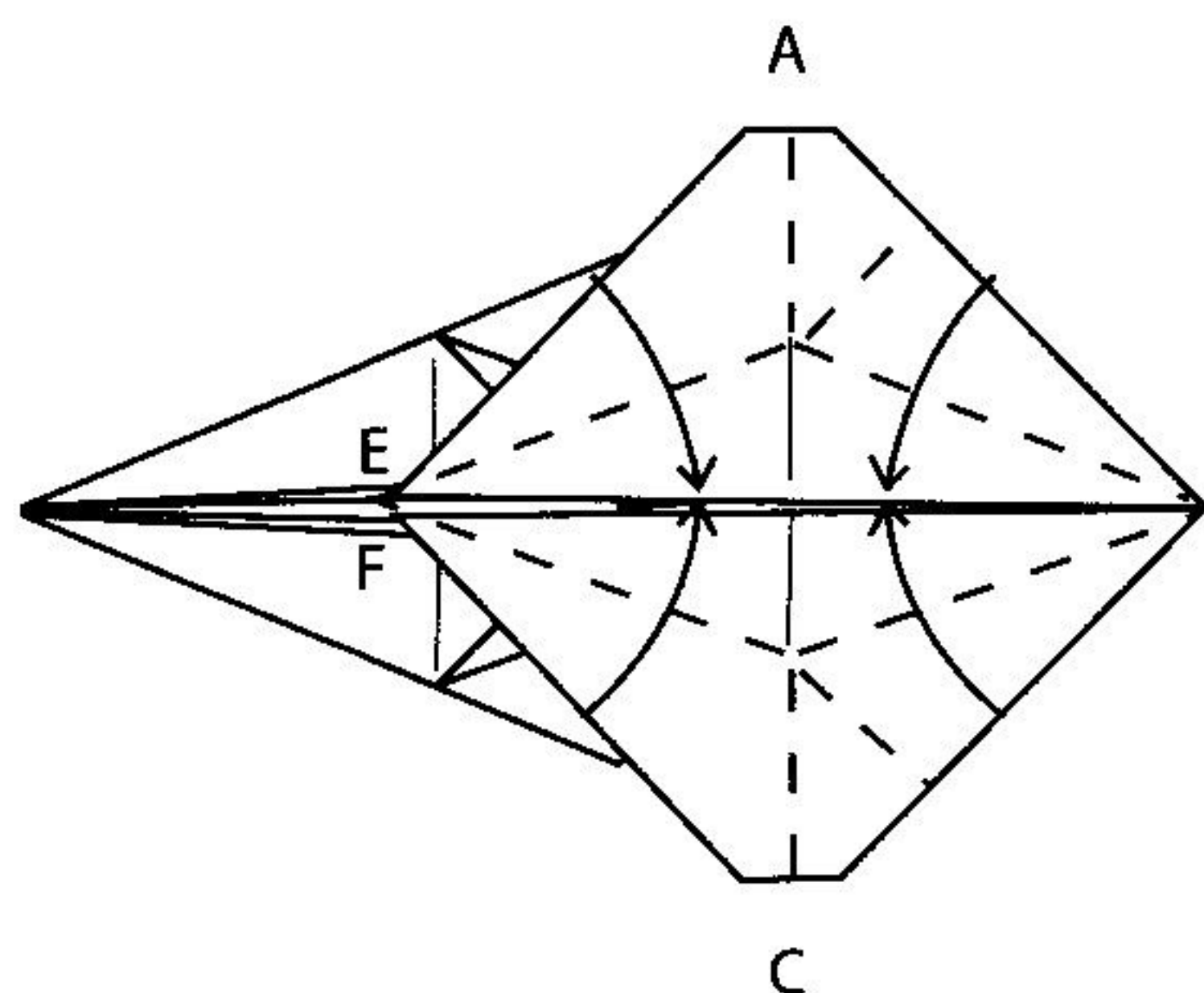


5. Fold in all four sides of the left square to the center while folding corners B and D in half and to the right.

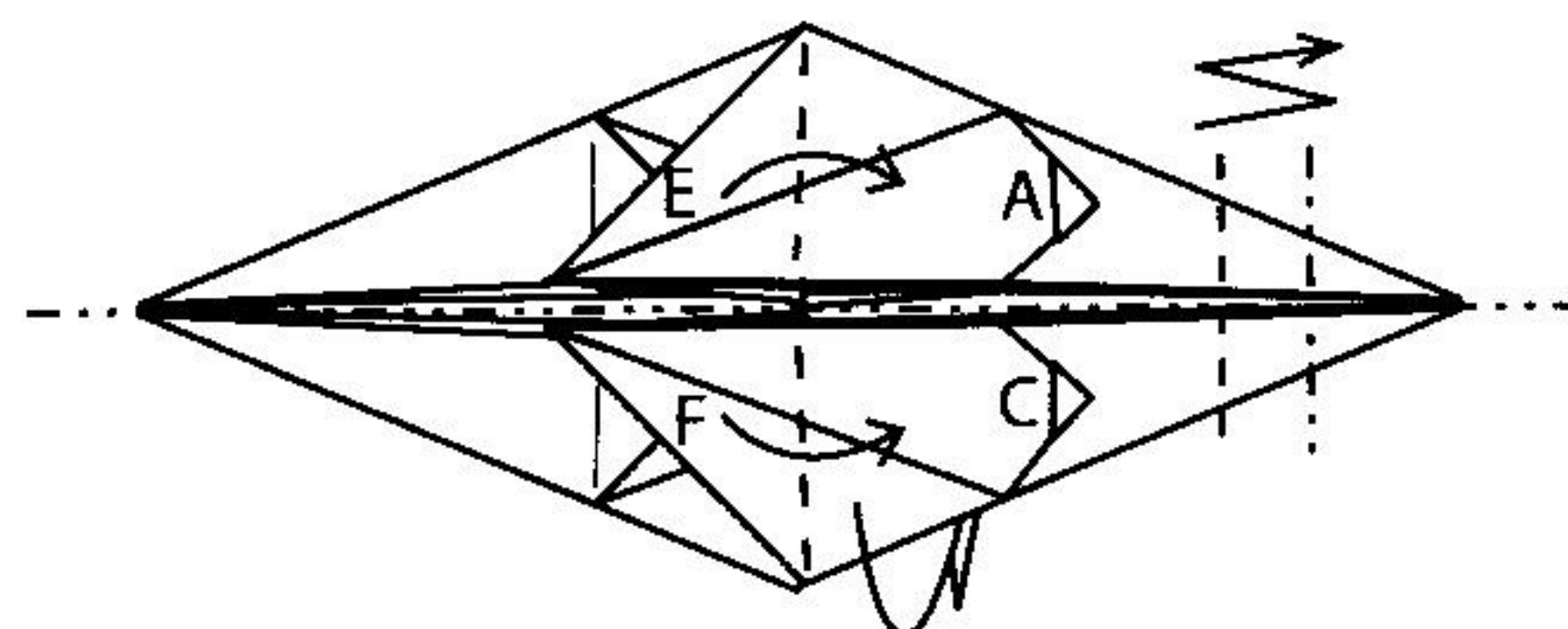


6. Fold E and F to the left. Mountain-fold a small amount of A and C under.

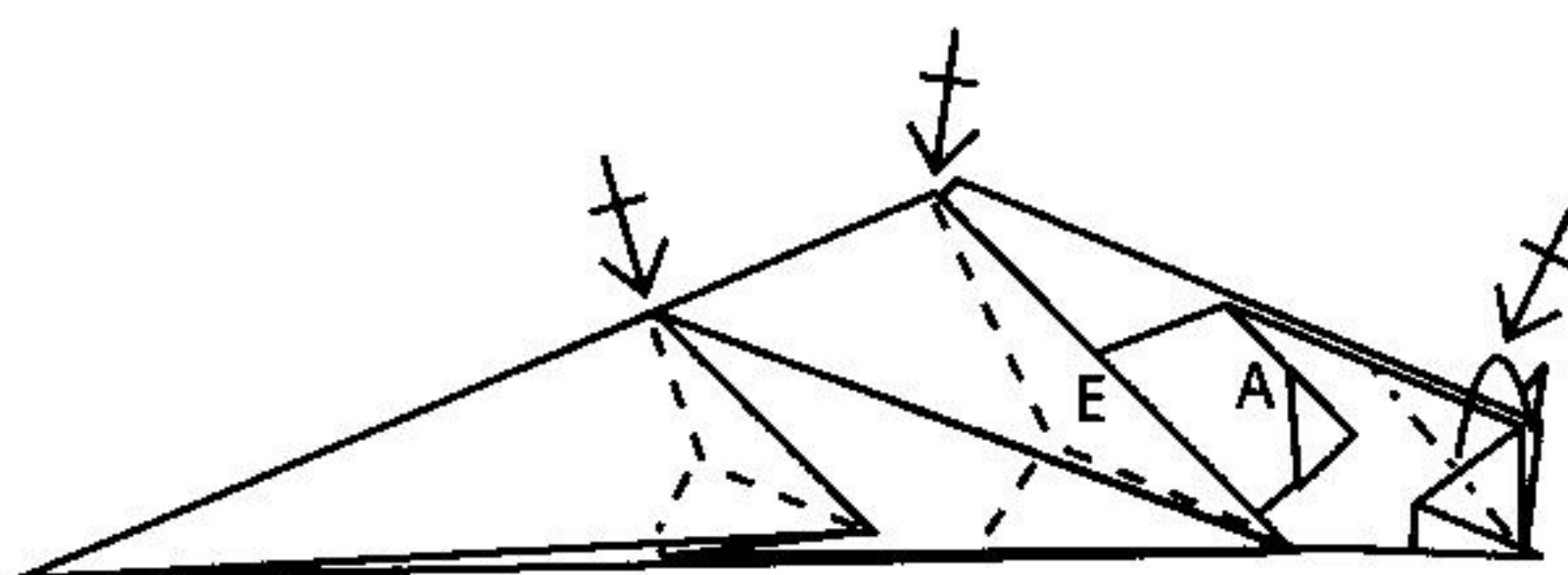
Chameleon



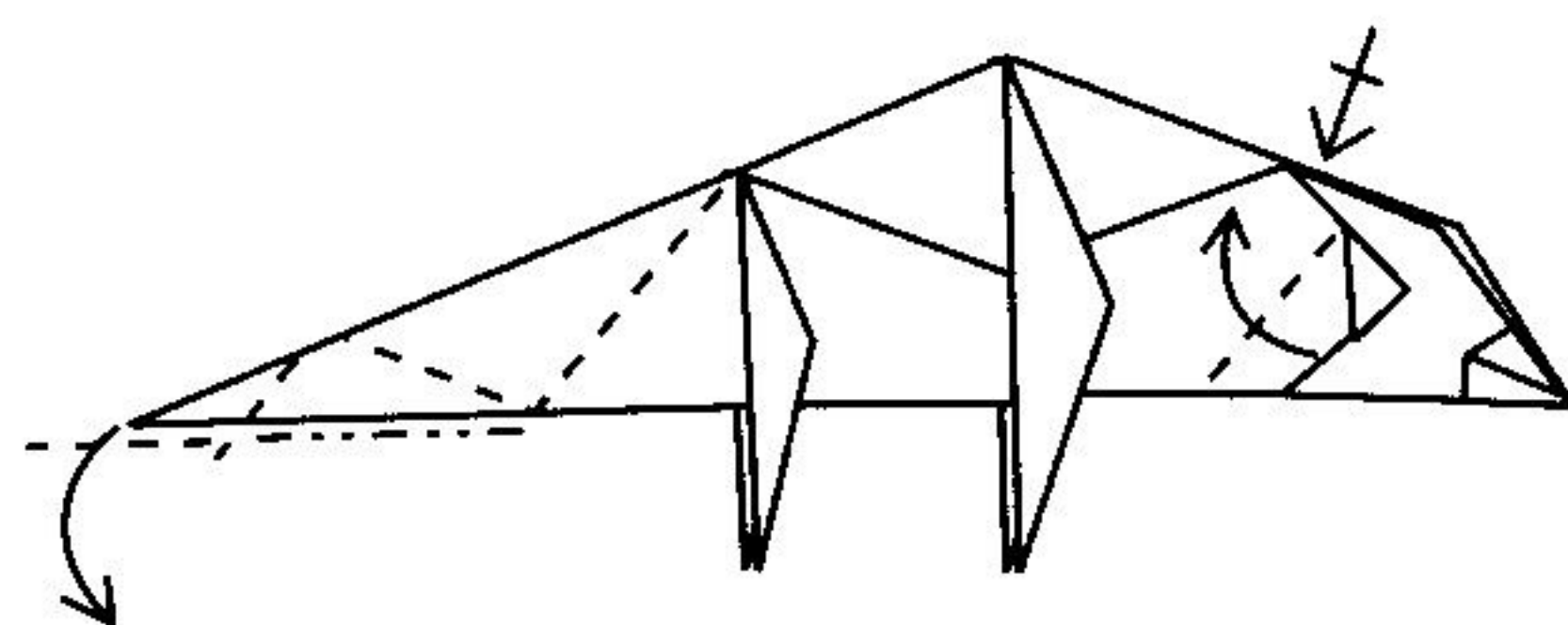
7. Fold in all four sides of the right square to the center while folding A and C in half and to the right.



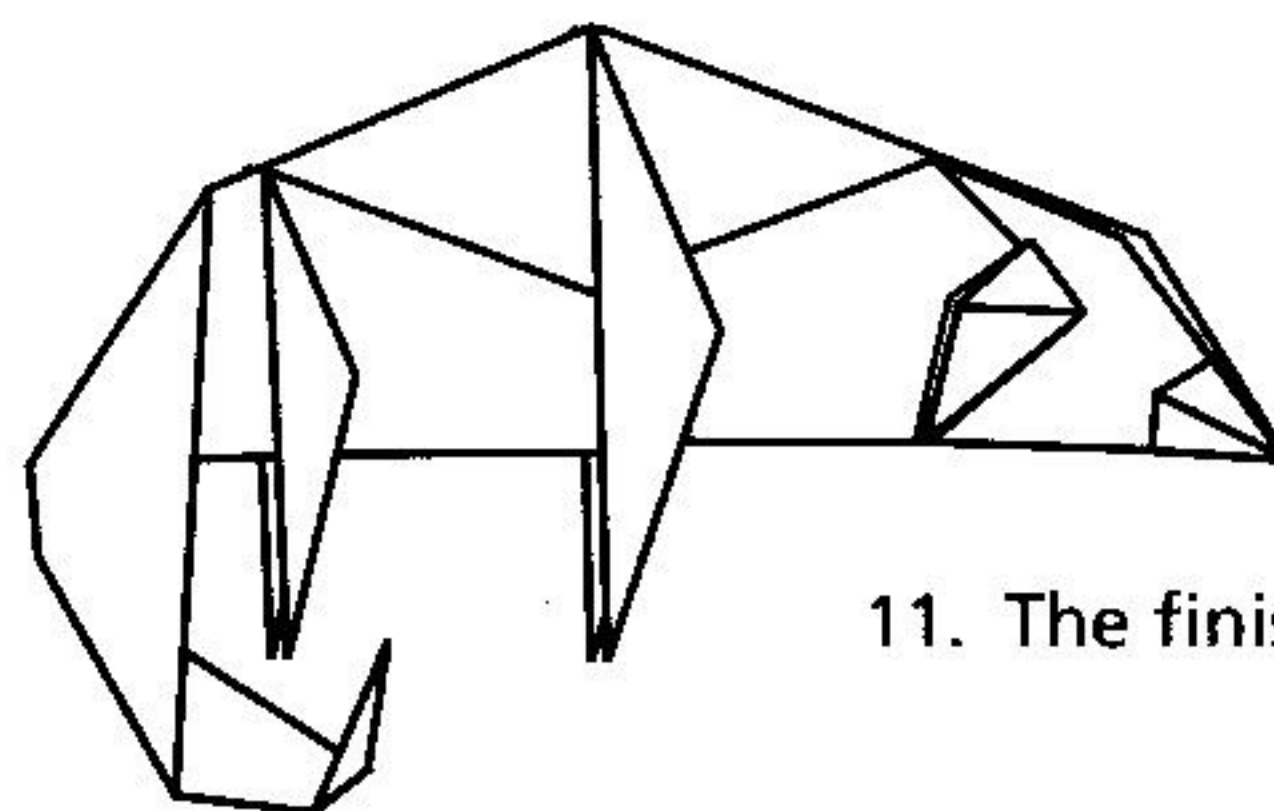
8. Fold E and F to the right. Mountain- and valley-fold the right corner to make the mouth. Mountain-fold in half the long way. Rotate.



9. Make the legs by folding corners in half and then down. Mountain-fold the front corners of the head inside.

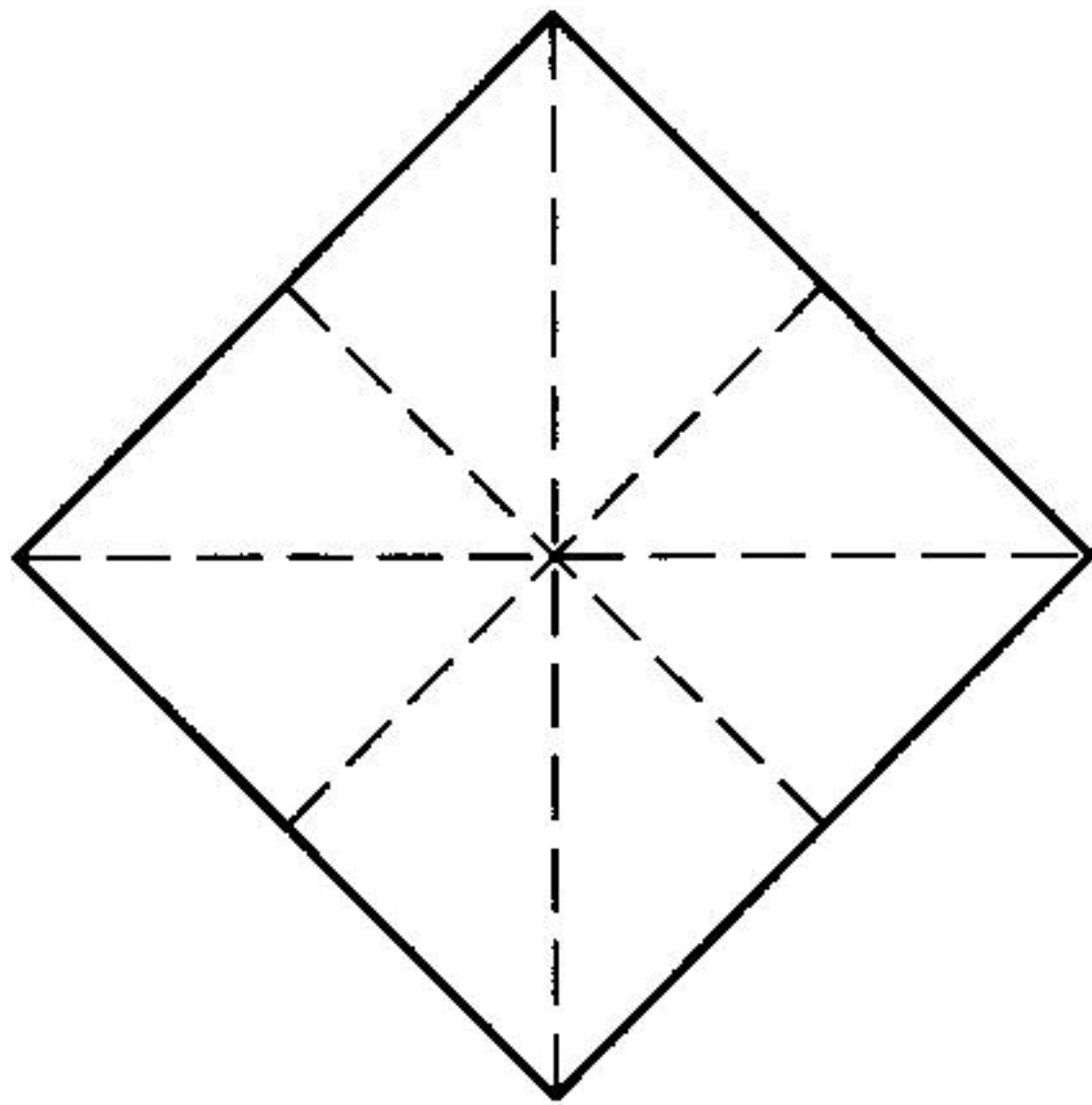


10. Fold up the eyes. Curl the tail with a series of outside and inside reverse folds.

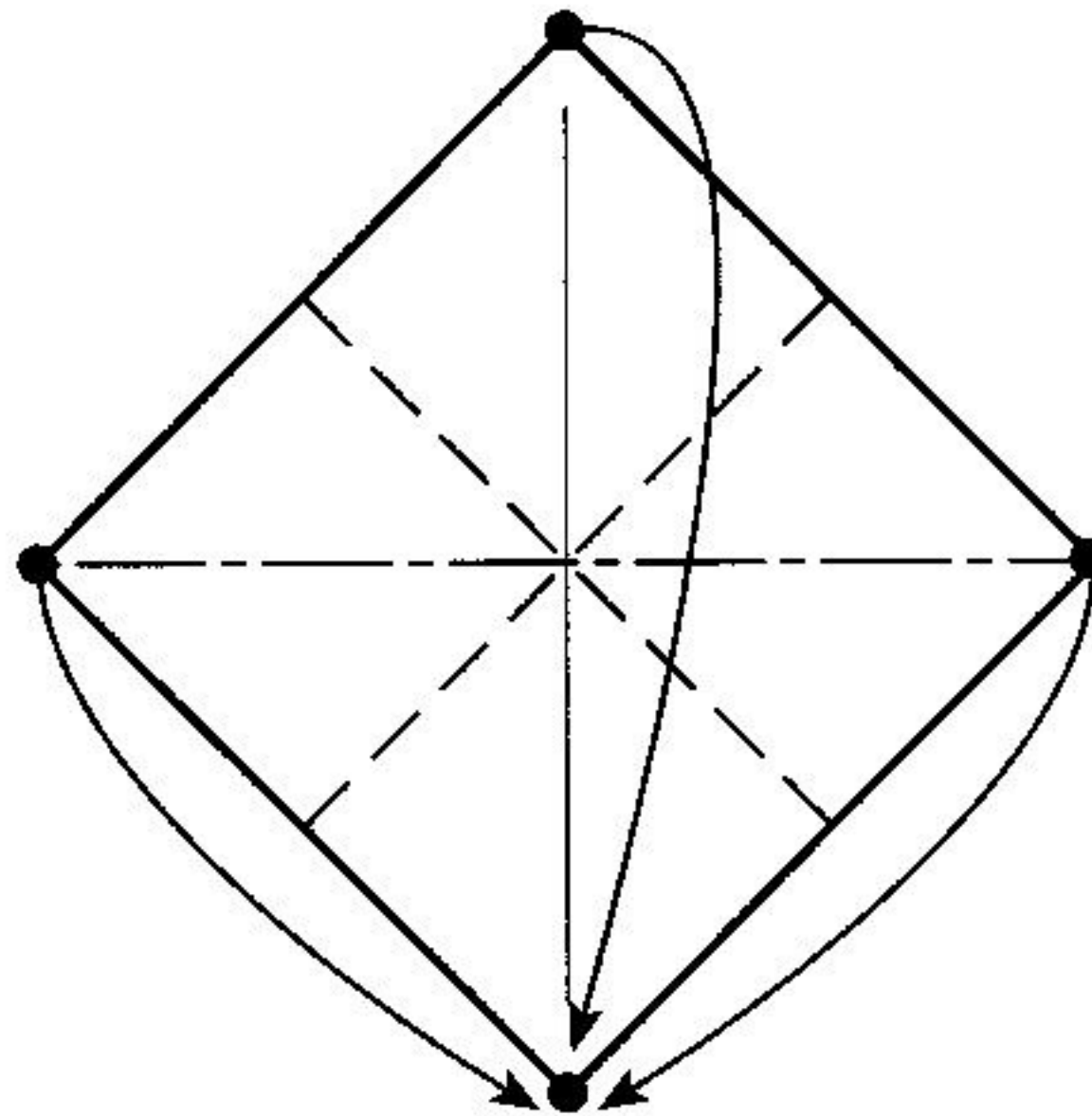


11. The finished Chameleon.

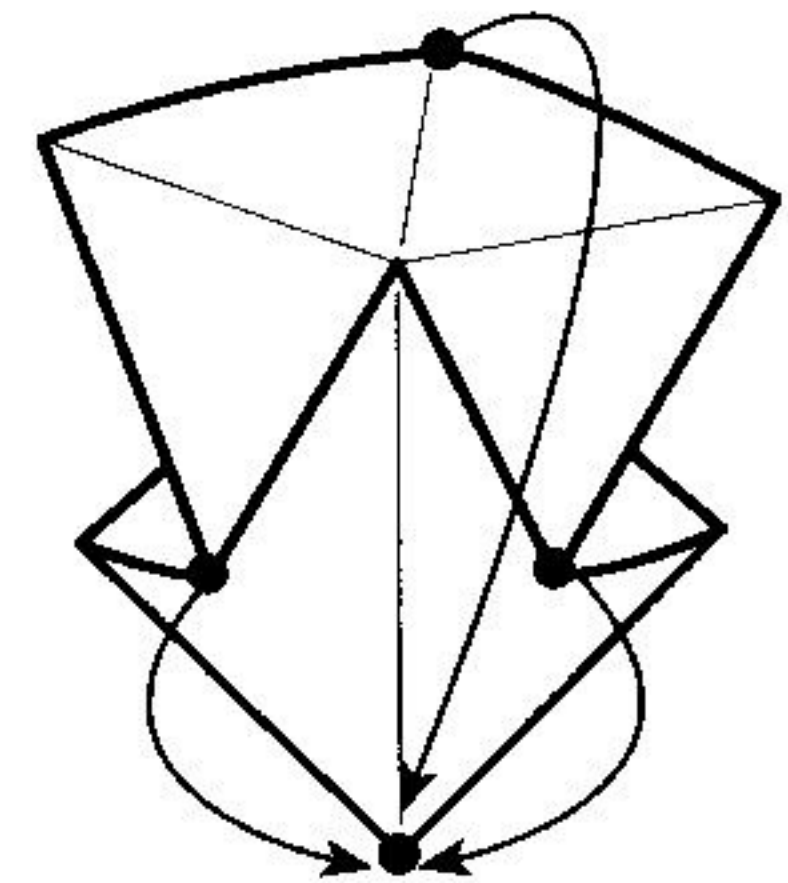
Crane



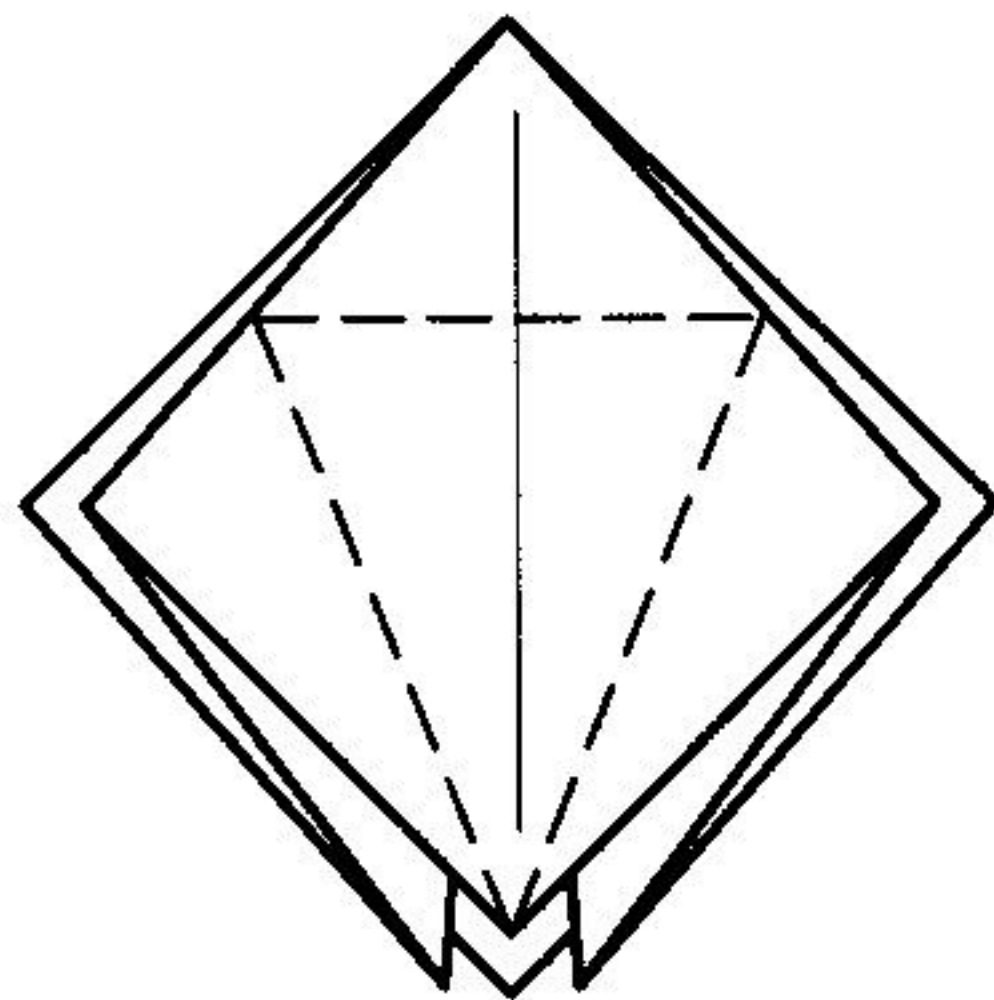
1. Crease in half along the diagonals and the sides.



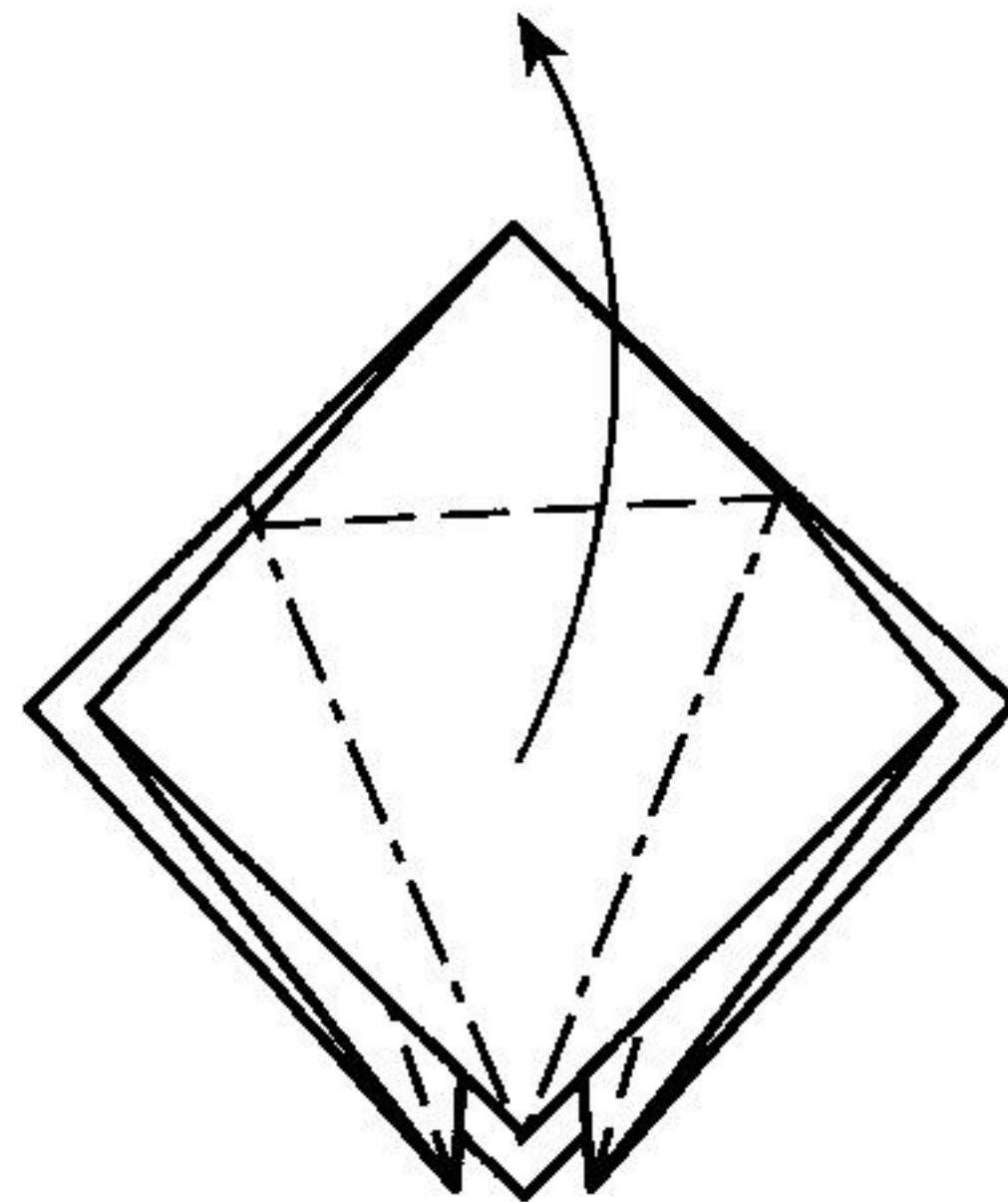
2. Bring the three corners to meet the bottom corner.



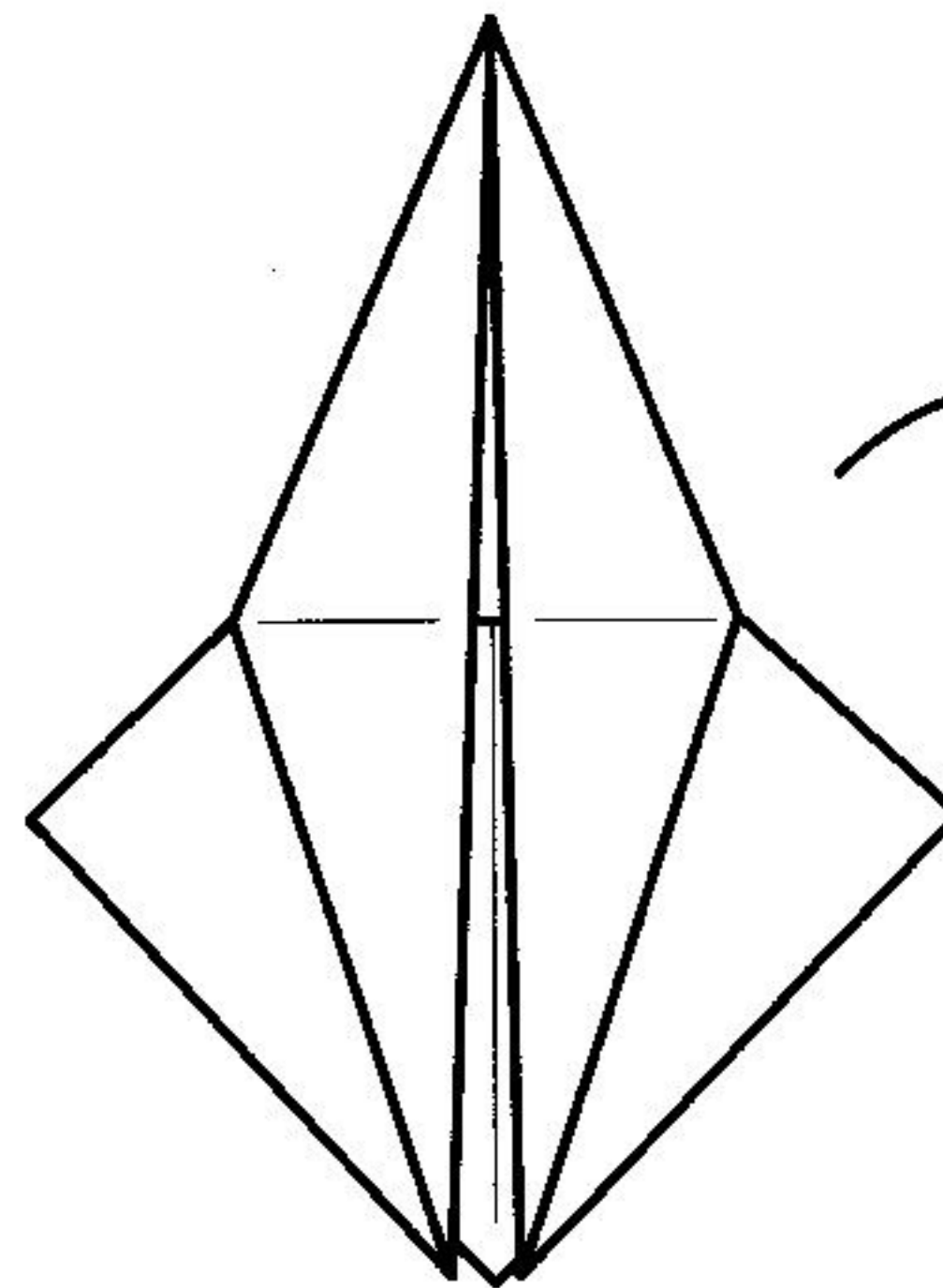
3. In progress...



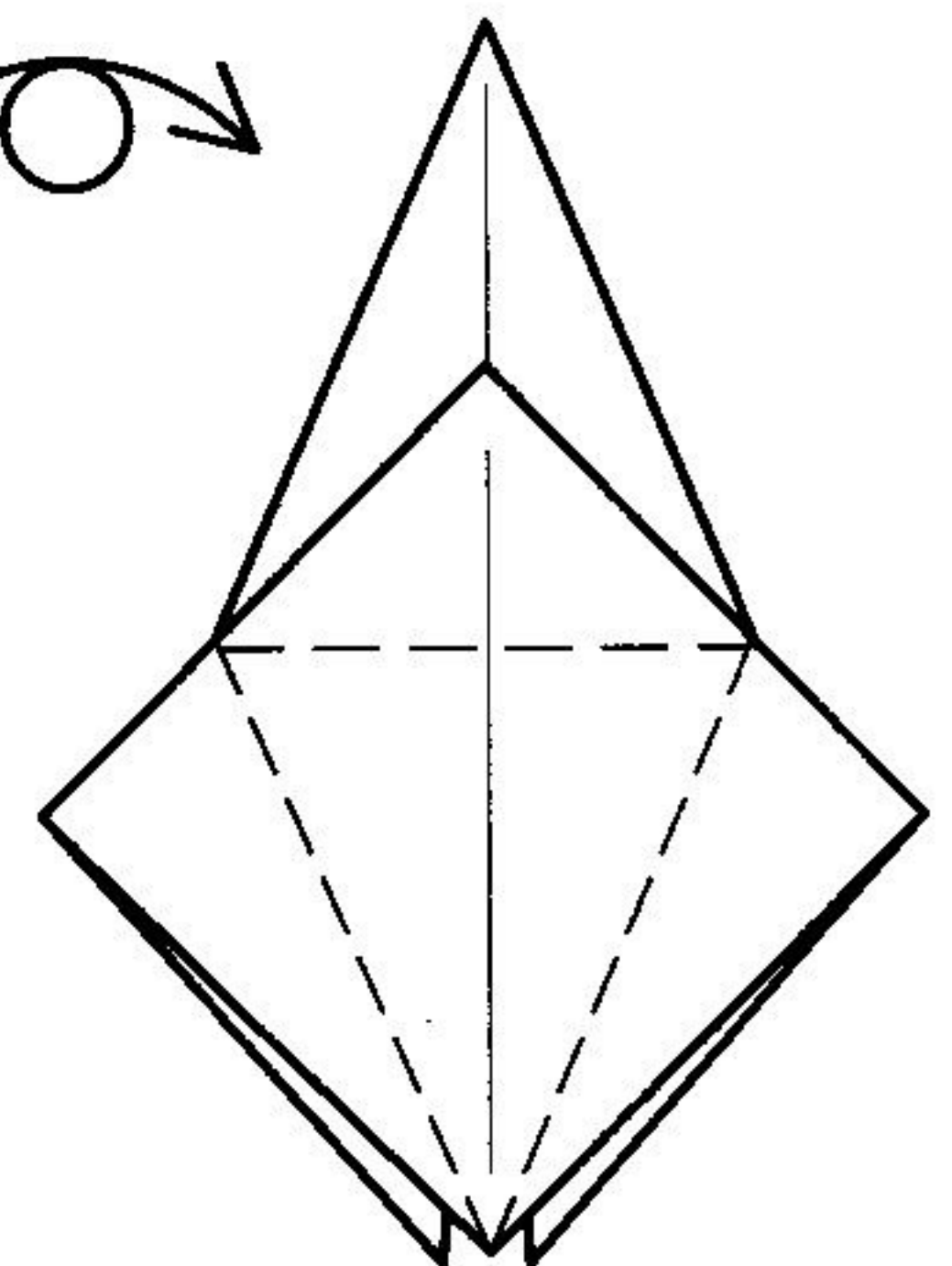
4. Crease by folding the sides to the center and unfolding.



5. Pull the corner up, allowing the sides to meet at the center.

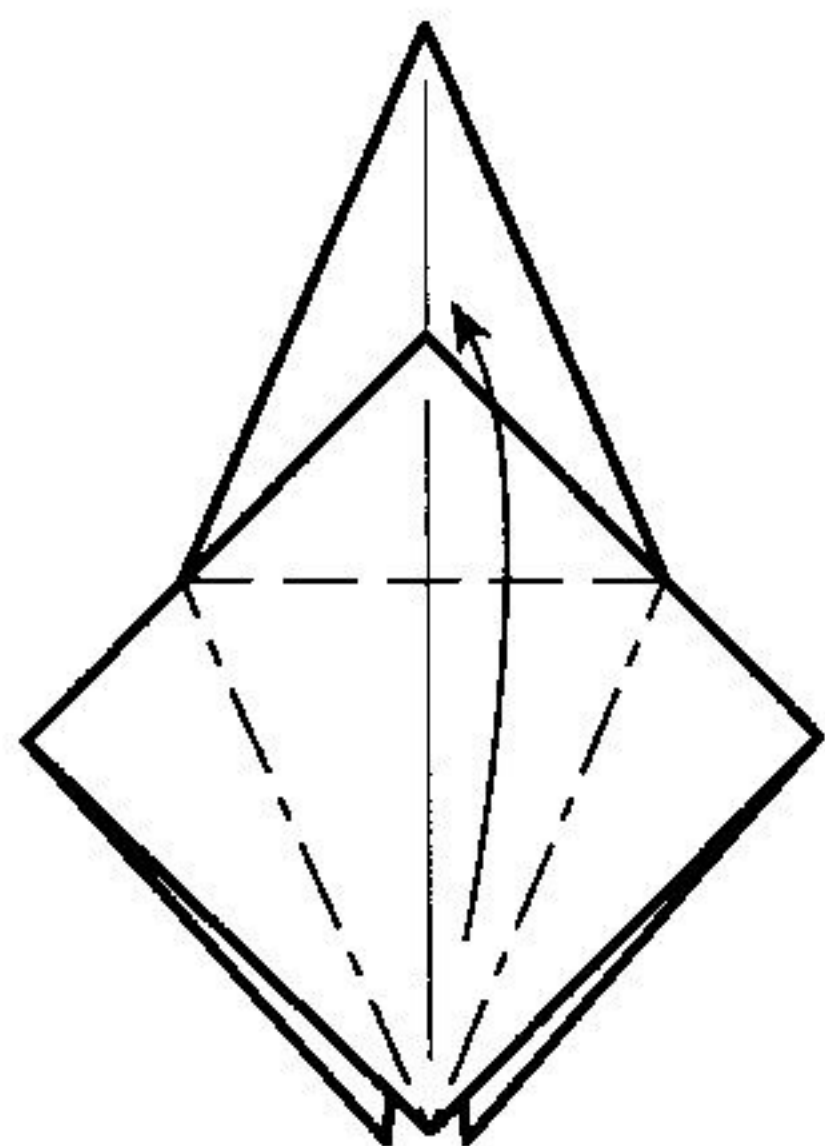


6. Turn over.

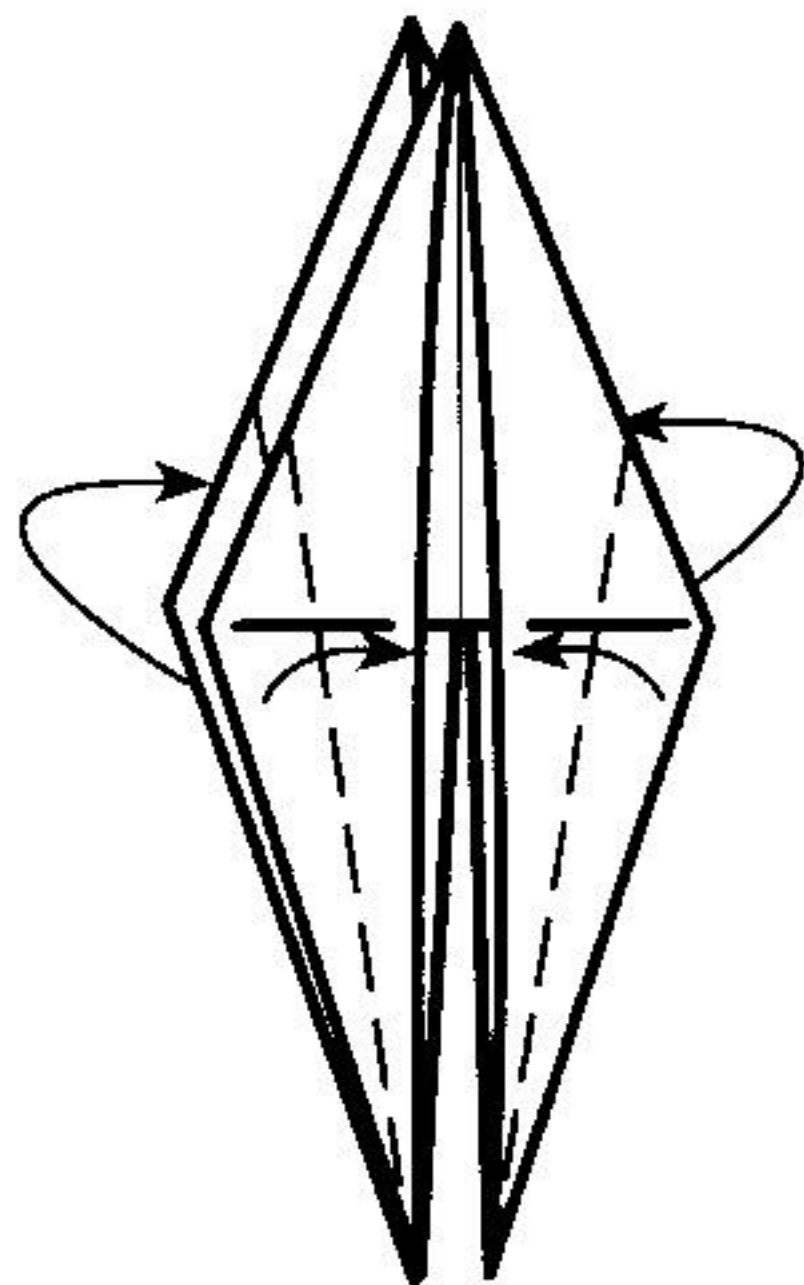


7. Crease the top section.

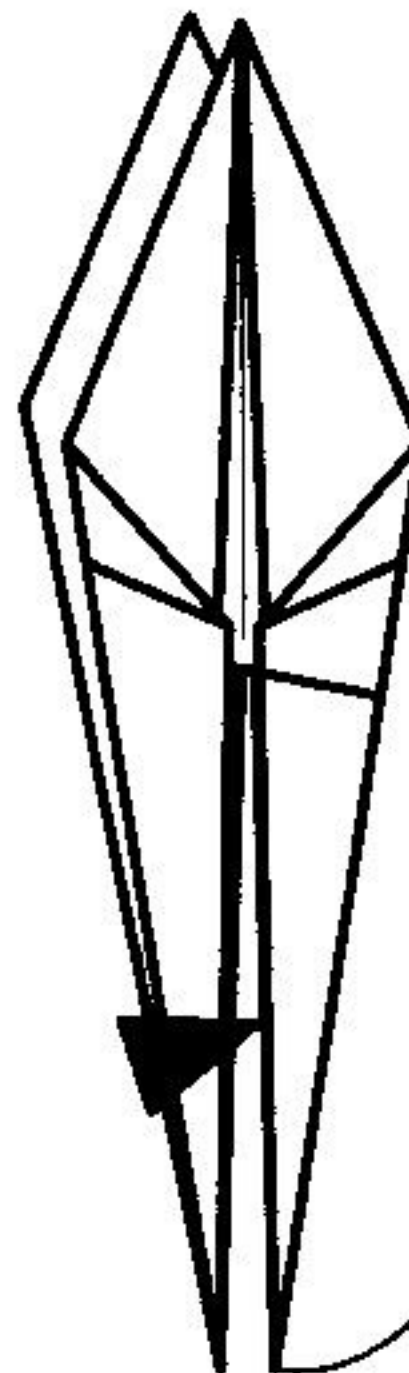

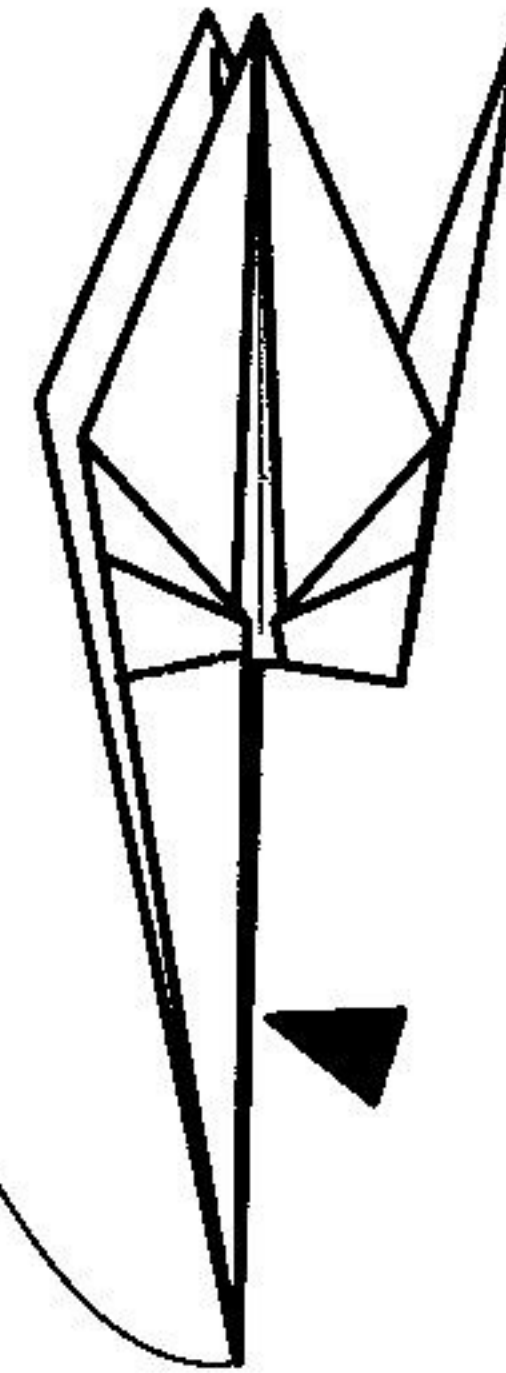
8. Pull the corner up as in step 5.



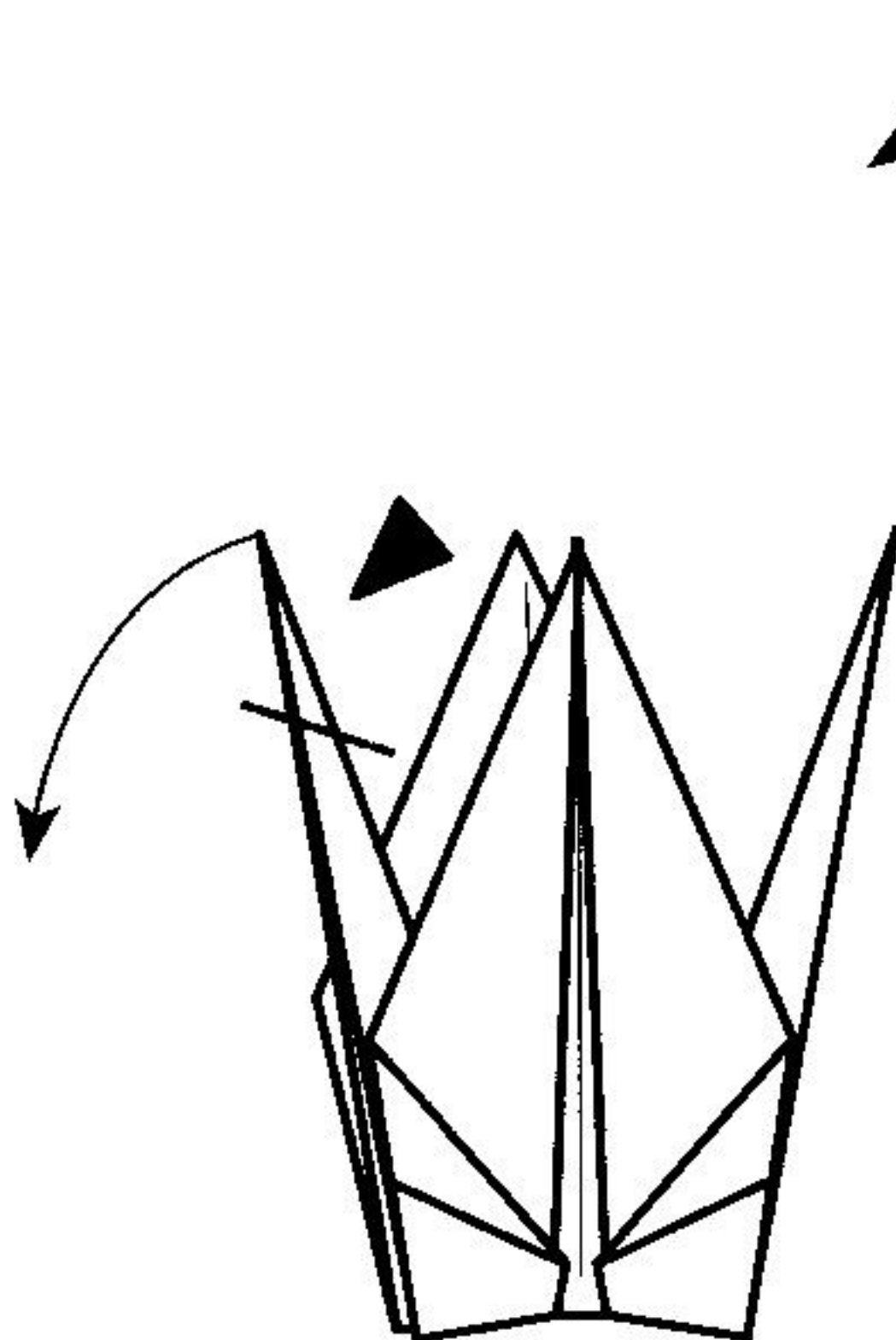
9. Fold the sides to the center and repeat behind.



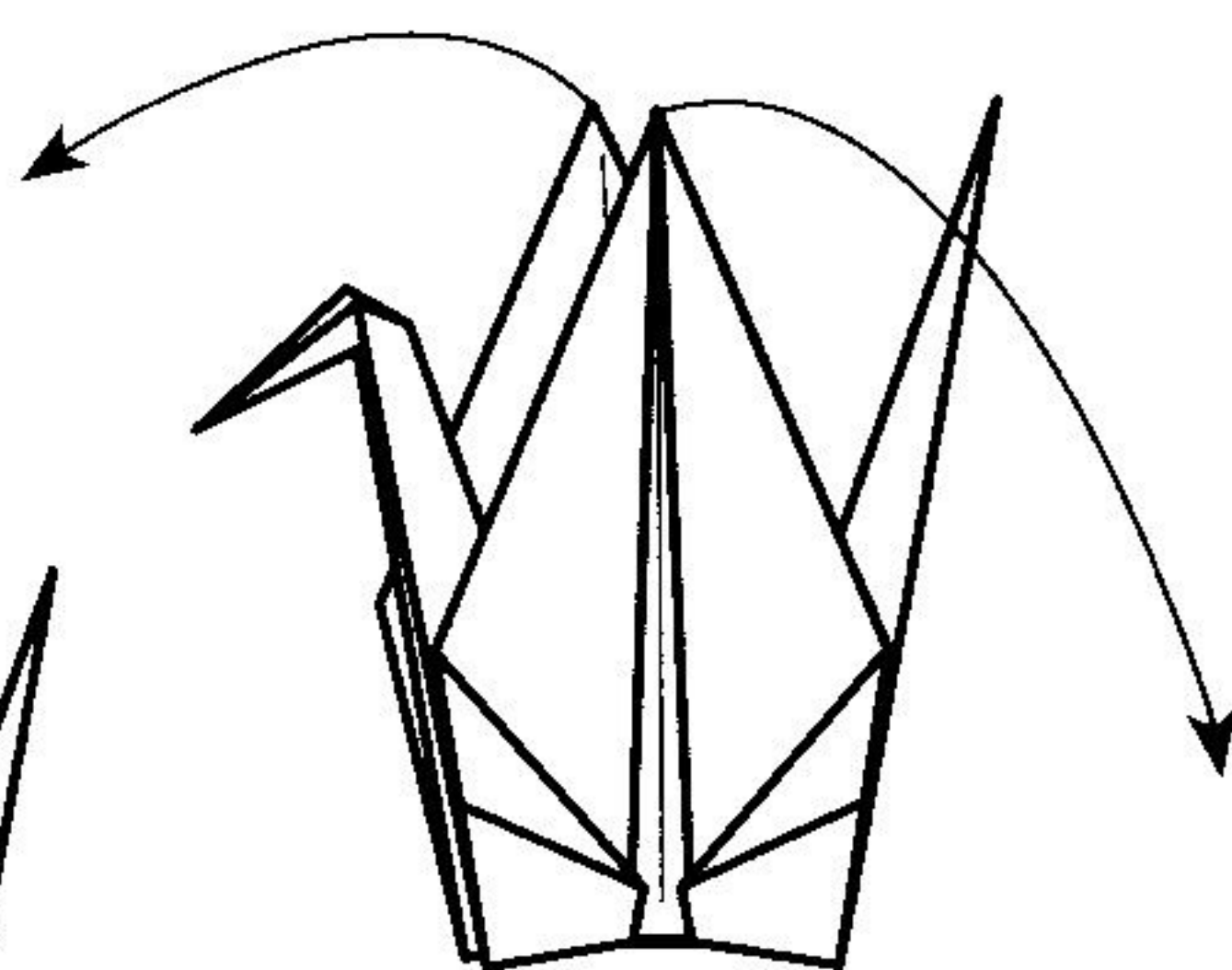
10. Inside-reverse fold the flap upwards.



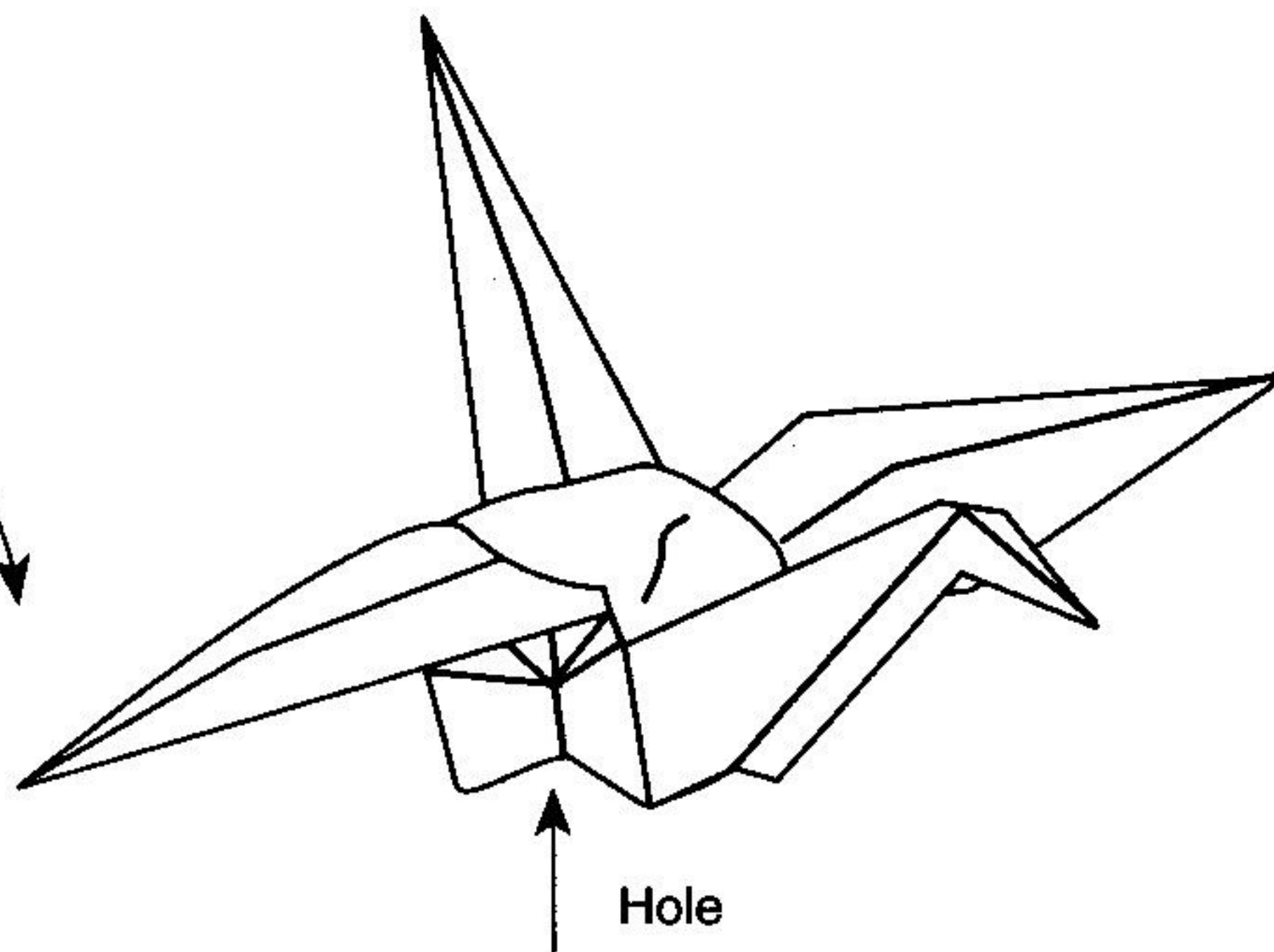
11. Inside-reverse fold the other flap.



12. Inside-reverse fold the tip of the flap down.

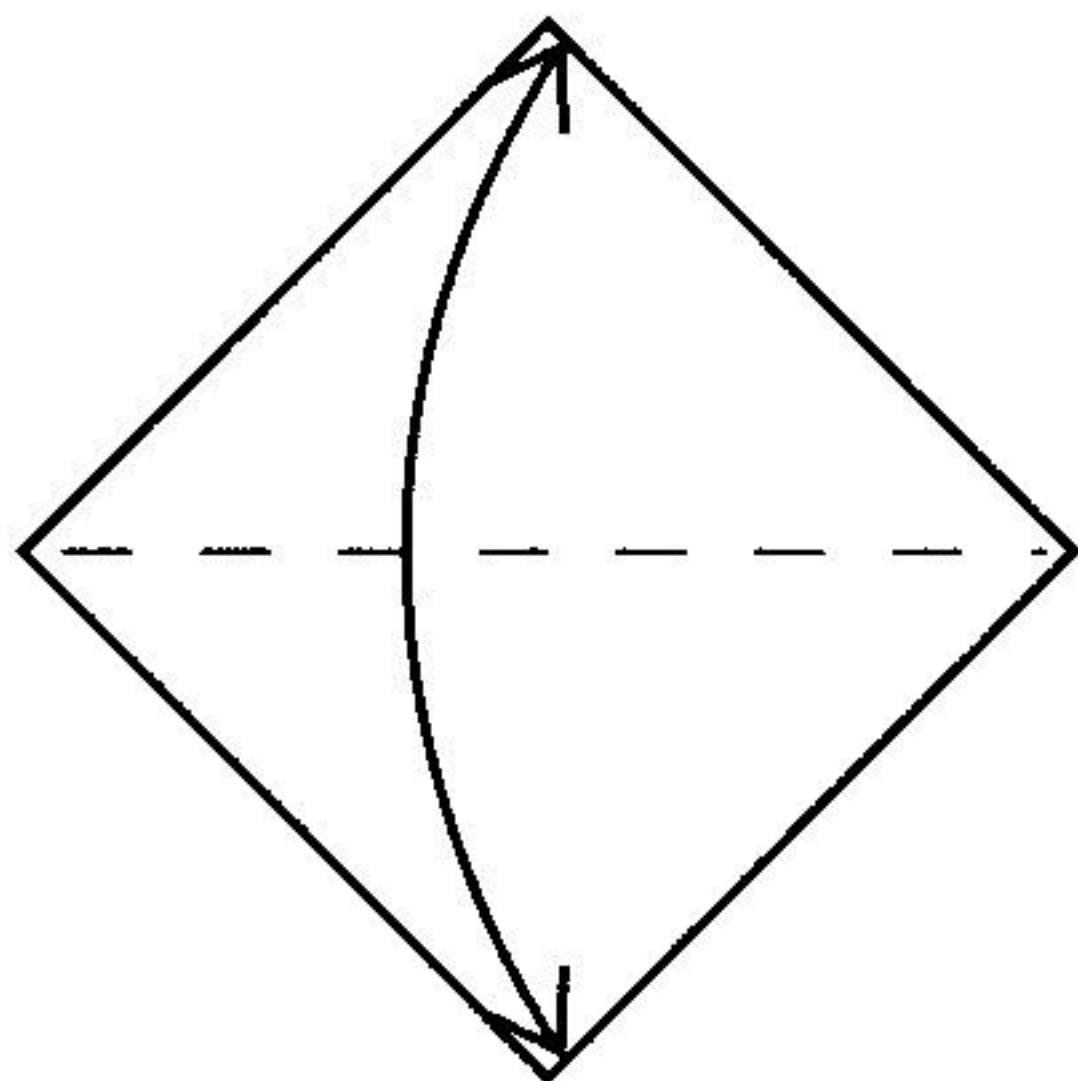


13. Pull the wings apart.

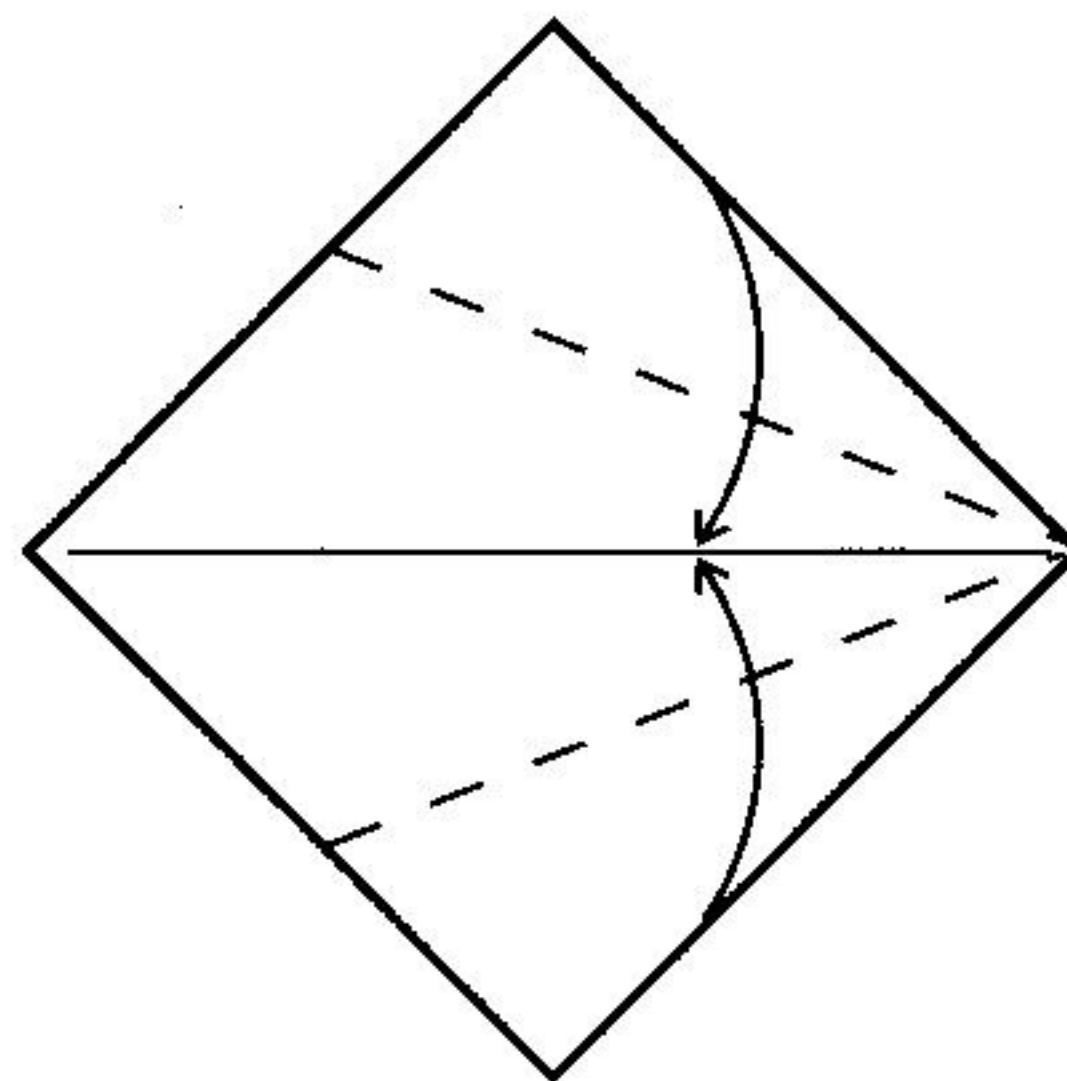


14. Completed Crane.
You can blow in the bottom hole to give it more volume.

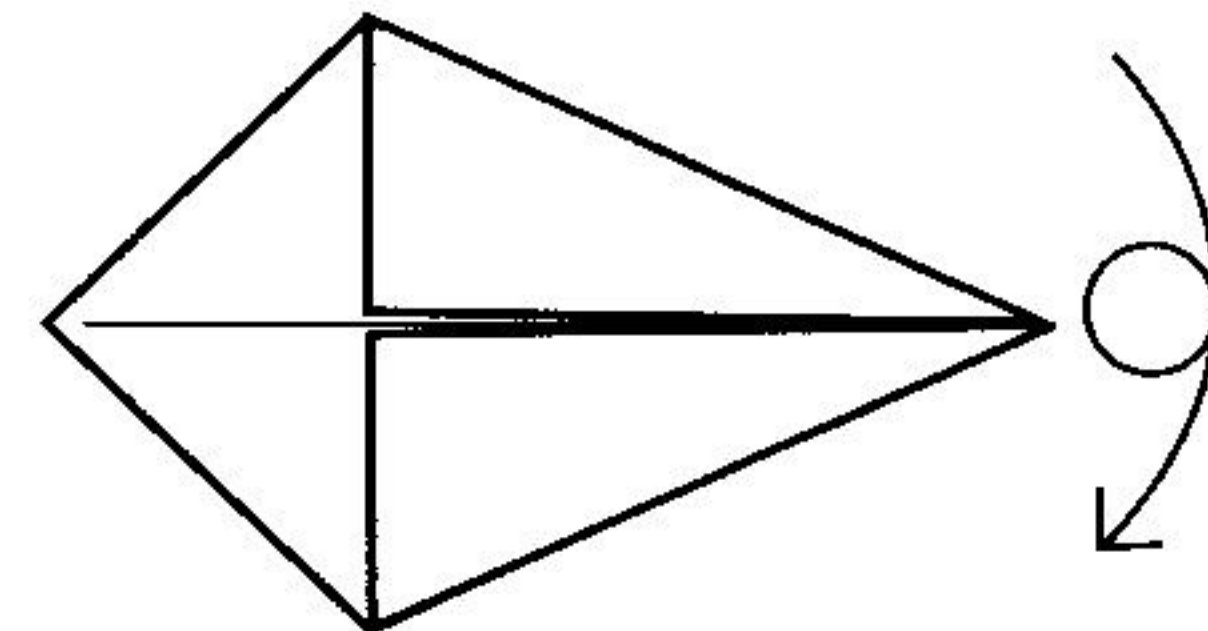
Mother and Baby Duck



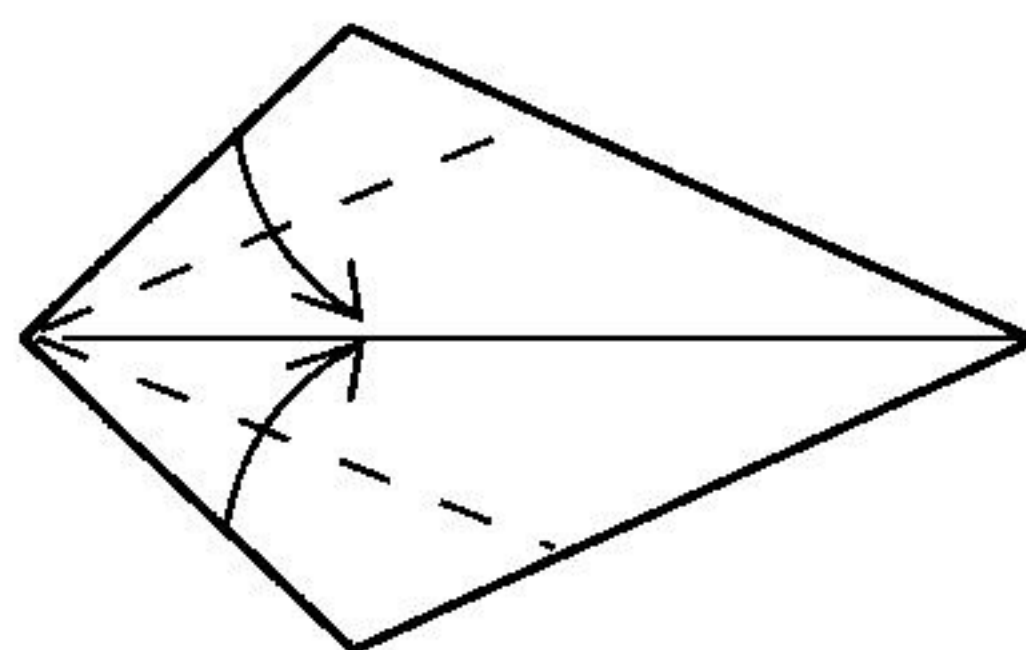
1. Fold in half, bottom corner to top corner. Unfold.



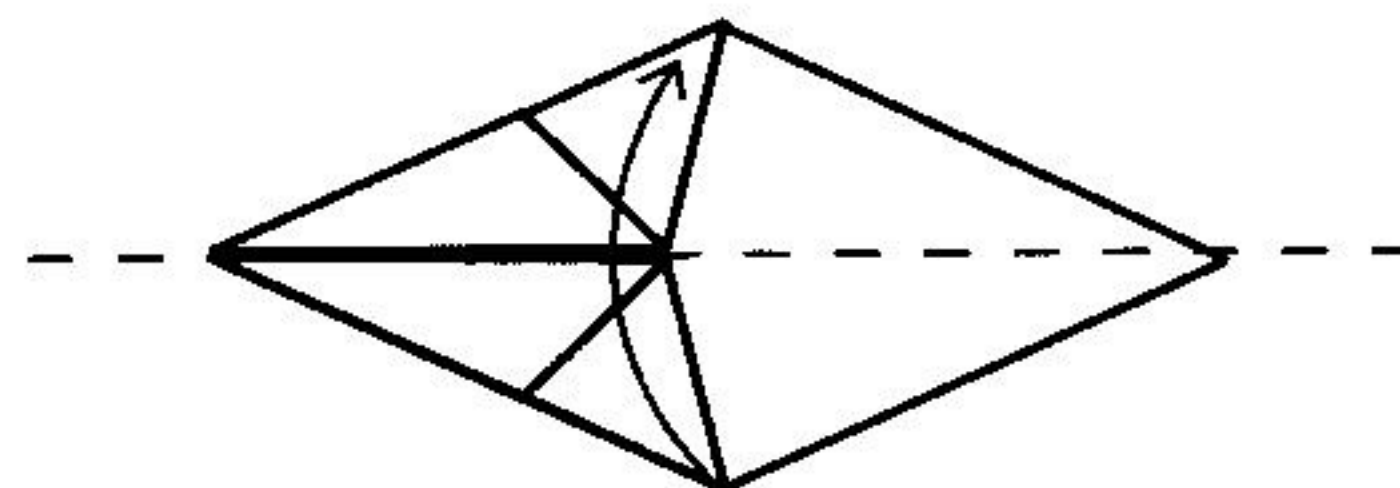
2. Fold the right edges to the center crease to make a kite.



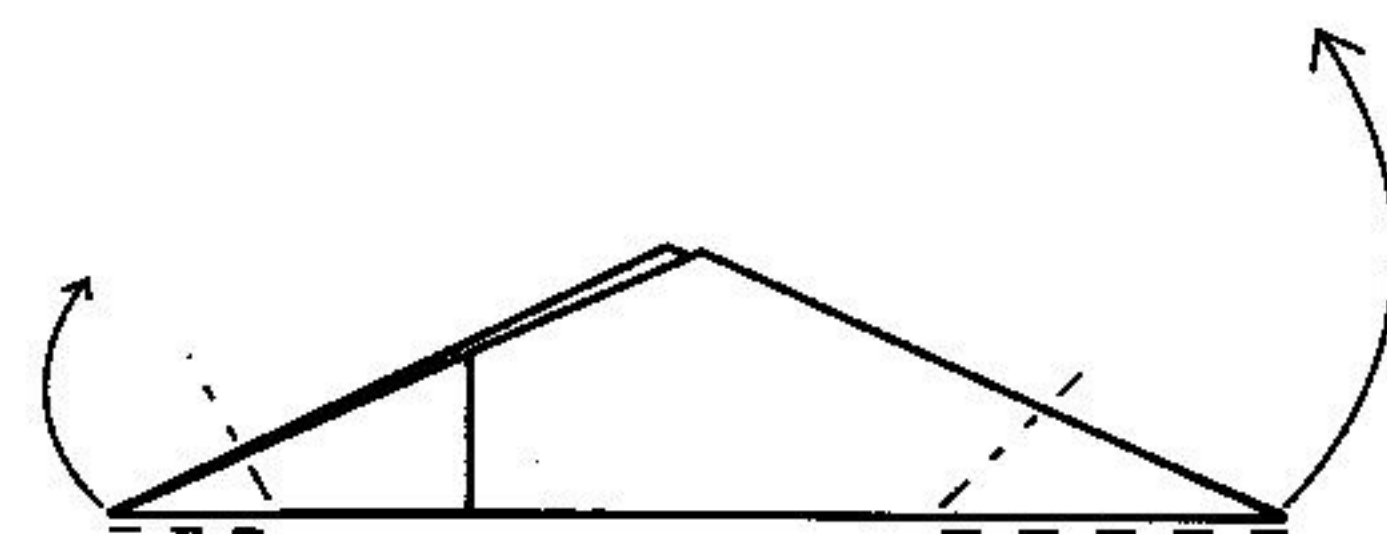
3. Turn over, top to bottom.



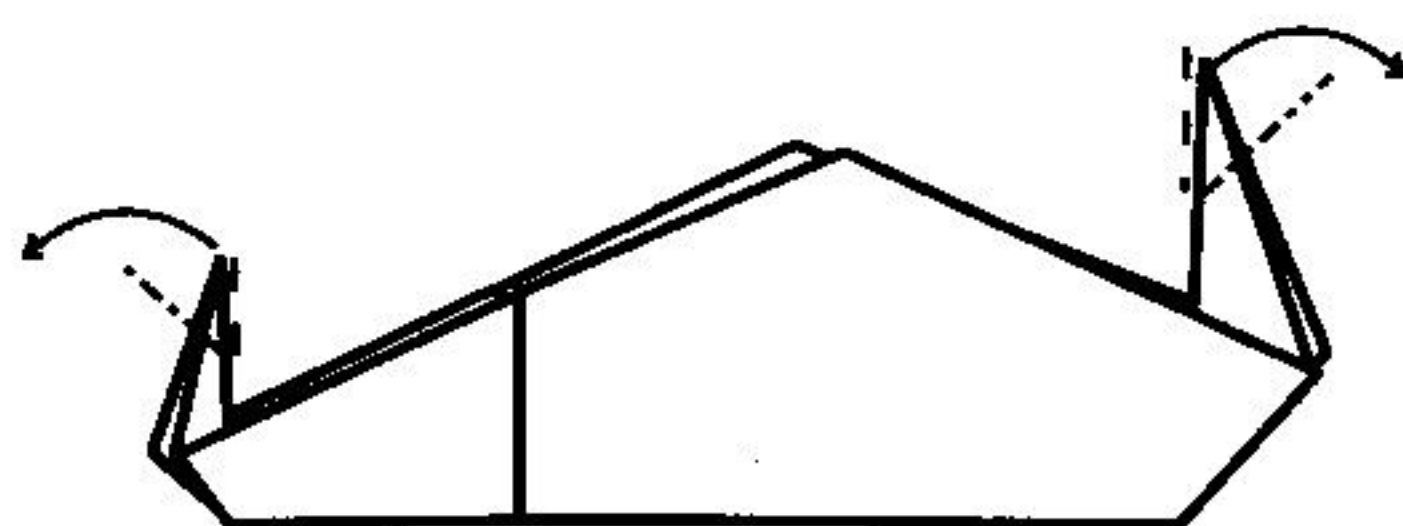
4. Fold in the left edges to the crease, making a diamond shape.



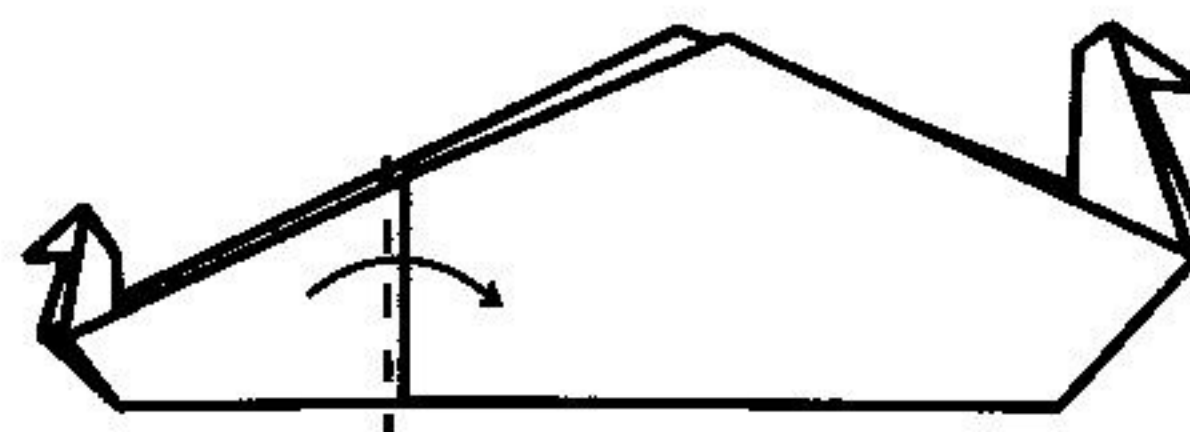
5. Fold in half, bottom corner to top.



6. Inside-reverse-fold each end to form the neck of each duck.



7. Inside-reverse-fold each end to form the neck of each duck.



8. Fold the baby duck over the back end of the mother duck.



9. Fold the back corner behind. A finished Mother and Baby Duck.
